

Remarks on Board Ship *Trinidad* Thursday May 11th 1859

This day came in with a gale of wind from the NW. the ship heads N. at 8 P.M. we sent the fore topsail and foresail the main sick and Bels at 8 in the night we took them in we are Laying too

Lat 35° 22' Long 161° 15'

Remarks Friday May 12th

This day came in with a gale of wind from the South and westward and at 6 P.M. sent the fore topsail and foresail the main sick and Bels at 3 A.M. Shook the Bells out of the topsails and sent the fore topsail mast stack in and sent a new one out.

Lat 48° 47' Long 152° 19'

Remarks Friday May 13th

This day came in with strong winds from the W. with hool topsails sent the ship heads W. by N. at 9 Last night pulled the topsails and furlled the mainmast and jib sent the mainmast and jib at 5 this morning the main sick.

Lat 50° 39' Long 150° 39'

Remarks Sunday May 15th

This day came in with strong wind from the W. the ship heads N. by W. with double Reef topsails rose new main tacks and Bells the same the main sick and Bels.

Lat 51° 57' Long 157° 48'

Remarks Monday May 16th

This day came in with strong wind from the W. the ship heads N. half W. with hool topsails sent and foregy at 12 P.M. and a Reef the topsails and at 3 A.M. sent them again and took ship saw one Salpeter Bottom and two new main topsail bracks the main sick.

Lat 52° 25' Long 161° 18'

Remarks Tuesday May 17th

This day came in with strong wind from the W. the ship heads N. with all sail sent at 6 P.M. took in the foremast sails and at 9 A.M. sent them at 9 A.M. took ship and rose new braces the main sick and Bels.

Lat 53° 25' Long 160° 18'

Remarks on Board Ship *Trinidad* Wednesday May 11th 1859

This day came in with Light wind from the N. by E. Steering N. by W. with all sail sent sent the new mainmast down and sent the old one up. we saw a finback latter part the same the main sick.

Lat 35° 22' Long 161° 15'

Remarks Thursday May 12th

This day came in with strong wind from the N. by E. Steering N. by W. at 4 P.M. we held to the wind and Steered N. by E. saw 2 finbacks at 12 Last night pulled the topsails and furlled the jib and mainmast at 7 more ship could not follow in sight and at 8 A.M. took in the fore and main topsails we are Laying too the wind from the N. ship heading E. by N. now Lat. now Long.

Remarks Friday May 13th

This day came in with a gale of wind from the N. the ship heads E. by S. and at 3 P.M. the wind held E. by S. the ship heads S. by E. and Laid out foregy we sent the fore and main topsails and jib at 4 A.M. more ship and the wind held to the S. Steering N. by E. we made sail the main sick.

Exp. Lat 56° 45' Long 160° 47'

Remarks Saturday May 14th

This day came in with strong wind from the S. Steering N. by E. with hool topsails sent at 4 P.M. saw a Right whale and heard the Bow and west Bells but with out seeing came on board at 5 P.M. at 10 P.M. 2 reef the topsails wind veered to the E. by N.

at 3 etc. hand the main sail jib fore and misser top sail 3 reef the main and hove to heading S. by E. on the lab. ord. tacks down end.

Lat none Long none

Remarks Sunday May 15th Came in with gale at 1 P.M. the gale broke at 2 P.M. under 2 reef topsails thick fog at 5 P.M. wind veered to the S. by E. at 6 P.M. Steering N. at 10 P.M. 2 reef the topsails and hand the jib at 1 P.M. wind veered to the S. by E. saw one sail down end.
