

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Monday May 16th 1852

Come in with strong wind from the west under reefed topsails moderates at 9 Pm under topsails saw one spout middle and later part calm broke out provisions at 10 Pm light wind from the se steering nne with all sail

Remarks Tuesday May 17th

Come in with light wind from the se steering nne with all sail saw hump backs middle and later part the same with rain at 7 Pm saw the land rose island then steering w by s for the land then steering sw

Lat 54:03 Long 146:04

Remarks Wednesday May 18th

Come in with light wind from the se at 8 Pm veered ship heading e by s at 8 Pm steering nne by land 18 miles distant middle and later part light wind at 9 Pm wind veered to the e heading nne saw the main land saw sail

Lat 54:32 Long 144:36

Remarks Thursday May 19th

Come in with light wind from the e heading on boat backs saw the land at 10 Pm strong wind reefed the topsails saw 3 sails gamming with the trawl and gay head spoke the um tee broke out one bbl of bread rowends

Remarks Friday May 20th

Come in with strong wind from the e heading se under reefed topsails at 9 Pm hand missen topsail and jib at 8 Pm furld the fore topsail and reefed the main with fresh gale at 8 Pm set fore and missen topsails saw 3 sail heading on path tacks

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Saturday May 21st 1852

Come in with strong wind from the e heading heading nne under reefed topsails at 8 Pm main top gallin sail and flying jib come in squally at 9 Pm reefed the topsails and furld the flying jib at 10 Pm hand the jib and mainsail saw the land at 5 Pm veered ship at 8 Pm heading se at 11 Pm moderates and wind hauled to the e heading se saw the land

Lat 54:28 Long 143:56

Remarks Sunday May 22nd

Come in with strong wind from the e heading se under reefed topsails at 8 Pm made sail main top gallin sail and flying jib saw hump backs middle and later part light wind and pleasant at 9 Pm lored 4 boats for grampus without success at 10 Pm lored for pinbacks without success came on board at 12

Lat 53:52 Long 143:57

Remarks Monday May 23rd

Very pleasant with light wind from the e then veered to the n heading on boat tacks at 2 Pm lored 2 boats for pinbacks without success came on board at 4 Pm 30 mts Pm at 8 Pm gamming with the gay head and good return saw 5 sail middle and

later part wind baffling from all points of the compass saw hump backs

Come in with light wind and baffling from all points of the compass saw pinbacks saw 4 sail caught one seal at 10 Pm light wind from the e and freshen to a gale at 5 Pm furld top gallin sails and reefed the topsails at 8 Pm furld fore and missen topsails and hand the wires goose winged main topsail
