

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Friday June 3rd 1857

Came in with moderate wind from the w heading on both tacks saw fin backs middle and later part calm at 7th 4 boats went in shore for spars broke out water

Remarks Saturday June 4th

Came in calm saw fin backs boats came on board at 8th with 5 spars middle and later part calm employed in lashing up spars saw sail saw the land

Lat 53:11 Long none
Remarks Sunday June 5th

Came in calm employed in running down salt water in the main hatch at 8th gamming with the bk bone of Bedford clear at 11th wind from the e heading on both tacks at 12th fresh squalls drift the top sails at 5th made all sail at 10th calm saw the land 20 mts distant saw 8 sails 2 boiling

Lat 53:07 Long 134:20
Remarks Monday June 6th

Came in calm saw hump backs and fin backs middle part calm at 6th light wind from the nne heading w by n saw sail saw the land south end

Lat 53:17 Long 134:26
Remarks Tuesday June 7th

Came in with light wind from the nne heading w by n with all sail middle and later part the same saw whale and herd 4 boats at 5th starboard both struck and kild took him along side at 8th and commenced to eat

149 lbs saw the land

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Wednesday June 8th 1857

Came in calm at 8th wind from the e with rain employed in getting got throw gh at 8th spoke the bk tank with 1 whale at 11th reefed the top sails later part employed in clearing up decks at 7th commenced to boil saw one sail saw the land

Remarks Thursday June 9th
Came in with strong wind from the e heading on both tacks employed in boiling at 3th reefed the top sails at 11th hand fore and misser top sail saw fin backs middle and later part fresh gale and rain saw ends

Remarks Friday June 10th
Came in with fresh gale from the e heading w with 3 reefed main top sail at 2th moderate set fore and misser top sail and fore sail and spanker saw fin backs employed in boiling middle and later part the same broke out procession and water

Remarks Saturday June 11th

Came in with strong wind from the e with fog and rain with 3 reefed top sails at 3th hoard up and made sail reefed top sails employed in boiling middle and later part the same saw one sail saw 1 whale going quick saw the land

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Lat 54:10 Long 142:14
Remarks Sunday June 12th

Came in with moderate wind from the e heading on both tacks employed in boiling boild down at 9th middle part employed in clearing up decks later part stowing down in the starboard side saw the land
