

Remarks on board ship *Kajestic* Friday June 24th 1859

Come in with strong wind from the sea heading *sw* at 2 Pm shoak the reef out of the topsails at 7 Pm wind strengthens middle part strong wind later part moderates at 10 Pm made all sail broke out broad sou winds

Lat 54° 37' Long none

Remarks Saturday June 25th

Come in with moderate wind from the sea with all sail set employed in making scrubbooms middle and later part heading *sw* with all sail

Lat 54° 03' Long 145° 33'

Remarks Sunday June 26th

Come in with moderate wind from the sea heading *sw* with all sail middle part the same at 7 Pm veer ship to the westward sou winds

Lat none Long none

Remarks Monday June 27th

Come in with light wind from the sea heading *unw* at 3 Pm wind veer to the *ne* with rain steering *unw* with all sail middle part the same later part wind veer to the *n* with all sail broke out meat sou winds

Lat 53° 10' Long 152° 41'

Remarks Tuesday June 28th

Come in with moderate wind from the *n* steering *unw* with all sail at 4 Pm steering *unw* bys middle and later part the same employed in sloping the cat head sou winds

Lat 53° 00' Long 154° 02'

Remarks Wednesday June 29th

Come in with light wind and calm saw hump and lord's boats at 5 Pm came on board at 8 Pm got nothing middle and later part wind from the *n* heading *sw*

Lat 52° 45' Long 159° 55'

Remarks on board ship *Kajestic* Thursday June 30th 1859

Come in with moderate wind from the sea heading *sw* with all sail saw fin back middle part the same at 6 Pm wind veer to the *n* with thick fog heading *unw* with all sail at 10 Pm hoard up saw siberian whale and lord's boat at 10 sou winds

Lat 53° 00' Long 155° 40'

Remarks Friday July 1st 1859

Come in with moderate wind from the sea heading *unw* with all sail at 10 Pm boat came on board got nothing at 2 Pm thick fog middle and later part the same with light and flitting wind on boat back sou winds

Lat 52° 55' Long 155° 02'

Remarks Saturday July 2nd

Come in with light wind and baffling with thick fog broke out molasses at 10 Pm wind from the *unw* with fresh breeze later part the same heading on boat back employed in making main top gallin's tacking sail boom

Lat 54° 15' Long 153° 21'

Remarks Sunday July 3rd

Come in with strong wind from the *unw* with all sail heading on boat back saw the land ~~off the island~~ at 10 Pm wind from the *unw* steering *unw* at 1 Pm hand top gallin's sails at 8 Pm made all sail saw sail

Lat 53° 25' Long 162° 23'

Remarks Monday July 4th

Come in strong wind from the *unw* with all sail heading *unw* at 2 Pm gamming with the roller tacked at 10 Pm calm later part the same saw fin back sou winds

Lat 52° 52' Long 152° 45'
