

Remarks on board Ship *El Bajestic* Sunday July 24th 1857

Come in with thick fog and light wind from the *East* heading on *loath* tack, ~~at 5 Pm~~ ^{at 5 Pm} came to anchor in 12 fms of water with 58 fms of *phane* gamming with the favorite middle and later part thick fog so winds this day

Remarks Monday July 25th
Come in with thick fog and light wind from the *SE* laying at anchor saw nothing middle and later part the same so winds

Sat none Songnone
Remarks Tuesday July 26th
Come in with wind from the *SE* laying at anchor gamming with the favorite got 60 lbs of black *lid* at 5 Pm fresh breeze from the *NE* at 5 Pm layed anchor and stood to the eastward then heading on *loath* tack, saw the favorite broke out for water so winds

Remarks Wednesday July 27th
Come in with strong wind from the *NE* heading on *loath* tack, with main top gallinsail saw the land ~~at 3 Pm~~ ^{at 3 Pm} reef the top sail and haul the jib and main sail middle and later part the same at 3 Pm made all sail

Remarks Thursday June 28th
Come in with moderate wind from the *NE* heading on *loath* tack with all sail at 4 Pm layed gamming with the favorite saw the land ~~at 5 Pm~~ ^{at 5 Pm} light wind and thick fog from the *East* steering *W by S* with all sail

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Come in with moderate wind from the *East* with fog steering *W by S* at 2 Pm cleared up saw sail at 4 Pm came to the wind heading *SE* at 5 Pm saw ripsack and lord 2 boats came on board at 7 Pm without success at 11 o'clock in flying jib and main top gallinsail at 11 Pm made all sail later part pleasant

Sat 68:15 Song 176:07
Remarks Saturday July 30th
Come in with light wind and baffling from the northward at 2 Pm thick fog broke out malasso at 10 Pm wind from the *SE* heading *SE* later part the same employed in sorting potatoes so winds

Sat 68:52 Song 176:17
Remarks Sunday July 31th
Come in with thick fog and moderate wind from the *SE* with all sail at 6 Pm cleared up saw 6 sail broke out meat and bread at 11 Pm pulled top gallinsails and flying jib later part the same heading on *loath* tack so winds

Sat 69:21 Song none
Remarks Monday August 1st 1857
Come in with strong wind from the *SE* heading on *loath* tack middle and later part the same saw the ice at 10 Pm saw 10 sail so winds

Sat 69:50 Song 168:47
Remarks Tuesday August 2nd
Come in with light wind from the *SE* heading on *loath* tack at 5 Pm lord 4 boats for us each boat got 1 apiece came on board at 7 Pm later part employed in skinning walrus at 3 Pm steering *SE* under top sail at 10 Pm wind increases at 11 Pm left to the *SE* heading *SE* by *E* so winds
