

Remarks on board Ship the Majestic Monday August 22nd

Come in with calm in play in whaling with 4 boats came on board at 10 Pm. without success close to the ice middle part fog and later part light wind from the S heading on loath tacks between the ice and land saw 11 sail seawards

Remarks Tuesday August 23rd
Come in with light wind from the S heading on loath tacks between the ice and land middle and later part the same saw 11 sail fog at times

Remarks Wednesday August 24th

Come in with light wind and fog from the S heading on loath tacks with all sail saw whale and land 4 boats at 10 Pm came on board at 4 Pm and land 2 boats at 10 Pm came on board at 10 Pm middle part calm saw whale and land 2 boats at 4 Pm came on board at 4 Pm got nothing brok out meat seawards

Remarks Thursday August 25th
Come in with light wind from the S heading on loath tacks between the land and ice middle part the same at 6 Pm wind veered to the S with fog and fresh wind under top sail saw 1 whale going quick land 2 boats at 7 Pm came on board at 11 Pm got nothing

Remarks Friday August 26th
Come in with strong wind from the S heading on loath tacks between the land and ice at 3 Pm running through the ice the ice closing in on the land part middle part wind died away later part calm saw the land bearing S with the ice closing in on the land saw 11 sail

Remarks on board Ship the Majestic Saturday August 27th

Come in with calm at 6 Pm came to anchor in the ice to keep the ice from driving her ashore land distant 2 miles at 10 Pm light wind from the S wayd anchor and made all sail later part in play in beating up between the land and ice ship in clear water brok out water foggy

Remarks Sunday August 28th
Come in with light wind from the S beating up between the land and ice bent main top gallin staysail at 7

8 Pm calm at 4 Pm light wind from the E steering S by E with all sail saw whale and land 2 boats at 5 Pm at 7 Pm boats down at 10 Pm waste boat struck and hild in the ice saw 11 sail

Remarks Monday August 29th
Come in with wind from the E running for the whale took him alongside at 3 Pm and let go the bow anchor and commenced to cut in got through at 4 Pm with fog and rain ends the same in play in clearing up decks

Remarks Tuesday August 30th
Come in with moderate wind from the S with rain at 1 Pm wayd anchor and went out of the ice heading on loath tacks between the land and ice at 3 Pm commenced to beat at 10 Pm wind veered to the S at 3 Pm ice closed in on the ship at 4 Pm running through the ice and receiving some damage at 6 Pm in clear water heading on loath tacks saw the land ends with fog and rain saw 11 sail
