

Remarks on board Ship *Majestic* Wednesday ¹⁸⁵⁷ ~~1858~~ ^{Sept 1st}

Came in with moderate wind from the S heading on both tacks employed in hauling saw whale at 5 PM and land 3 boats at 8 PM came on land at 8 PM got nothing at 10 PM strong wind swept the topsails employed in hauling and the same

Remarks Thursday September 2nd 1857

Came in with strong wind from the S heading on both tacks employed in hauling at 8 PM could down for the rain at 10 PM swept the topsails and hand the jib later part employed in stowing down in the main hatch 1857 saw ends

Remarks Friday September 3rd

Came in with fresh gale from the S heading on both tacks with swept topsails at 15 m started the work at 18 m went on at 9 PM light wind from the S steering from S to S E with all sail could down at 10 PM saw the land looked out meat and water saw ends

Remarks Saturday September 4th

Came in with moderate wind from the S steering from S to S E with all sail middle part light wind later part employed in stowing down ^{2323 fath} at 10 PM came to anchor of Cape Lisburn ^{Cape Lisburn}

Remarks Sunday September 5th

Came in with calm at anchor employed in getting water 125 fms middle and later part laying at anchor with fresh gales from the S at 12 fms of water with 45 fathoms of chain employed in stowing down water and clearing line broke out water saw 3 sail ^{Cape Lisburn}

Remarks on board Ship *Majestic* Monday September ¹⁸⁵⁷ ~~1858~~ ^{Sept 6th}

Came in with strong gales from the E at 8 laying at anchor under Cape Lisburn land bearing E employed in stowing away line middle and later part heavy gale at 12 PM moderate saw 3 sail saw ends

Remarks Tuesday September 6th

Came in with fresh gales from the E at 1 PM weighed anchor and stood in to the S with swept topsails mid part moderate later part calm made all sail rain and fog saw the land saw 3 sail

Remarks Wednesday September 7th

Came in with calm and fog with all sail at 10 PM light wind from the E heading on both tacks saw ends fog

Remarks Thursday September 8th

Came in with light wind from the E at 8 with all sail gambling with the main topsail and detterson saw 4 sail wind swept at 10 PM swept the topsail middle part the same at 11 PM blowing strong swept the topsails and hand jib and main sail ^{Cape Lisburn} saw the land 10 miles distant bearing S E

Remarks Friday September 9th

Came in with strong gales from the E at 8 with swept topsails at 10 PM hand fore and main topsail heading S middle and later part the same with snow saw ends

Came in with strong gale from the E at 8 laying at anchor with 3 sail main topsail at 12 PM wind veered to the S and ship heading S E middle and later part the same
