

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Thursday September 22nd 1853

Came in with light wind from the N. steering S. by E. with all sail sent up, masted top gallies, studding sail, booms and set the sails, employed in sail mending, broke out flour at 3 P.M. wind veered to the E. & E. head in the E. with all sail ends, the same

Remarks Friday September 23rd Came in with moderate wind from the E. by N. with all sail heading E. at 10 P.M. wind ship heading S. at 5 P.M. wind veered to the E. steering S. with rain saw black fish, middle and late part light wind and baffling from all points of the compass ends pleasant

Lat 47:26 Long 118:24

Remarks Saturday September 24th Came in with light wind and baffling from all points of the compass heading on both tacks ends the same employed in sail mending

Lat 48:42 Long 117:54

Remarks Sunday September 25th Came in with light wind from all points of the compass heading on both tacks, middle part the same at 4 P.M. wind from the N. steering S. by E. with all sail plenty rain ends the same saw porpoises

Lat 47:45 Long 116:22

Remarks Monday September 26th Came in with rain and squally from the N. steering S. by E. with all sail middle part the same late part wind from all points of the compass with rain broke out meat saw ends

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Tuesday September 27th 1853

Came in with rain and squally from all points of the compass at 10 P.M. hauled top gallies sails and flying jib at 10 P.M. 2 reefed the top sails and hauled the jib, middle and late part the same

Lat 45:16 Long none

Remarks Wednesday September 28th Came in with strong wind and squally from all points of the compass at 10 P.M. under 3 reefed, masted top sail and fore sail at 1 P.M. under 4 at 4 P.M. masted all sail, middle and late part rain employed in breaking out shoocks saw 1 sail ends with wind N. steering S. & half E.

Lat 45:32 Long 112:01

Remarks Thursday September 29th Came in with strong wind from the N. steering S. & half E. with all sail, middle and late part the same employed in setting up shoocks and making spungarn

Lat 41:00 Long 112:47

Remarks Friday September 30th Came in with strong wind from the N. steering S. & half E. with all sail at 11 P.M. wind veered to the N. late part the same squally

Lat 35:46 Long 114:54

Remarks Saturday October 1st 1854 Came in with strong wind and squally from the N. steering S. & half E. with all sail employed in making spungarn at 10 P.M. wind veered to the N. then to the E. ends the same saw 1 sail

Lat 36:15 Long 116:06

Remarks Sunday October 2nd Came in with strong wind and squally from the N. steering S. & half E. with all sail employed in all long down to 10 P.M. rigging at 3 P.M. steering S. & half E. middle and late part the same with all sail

Lat 34:35 Long 114:54
