

Remarks on board Ship, Majestic Tuesday November 1st 1859

First part men on shore later part employ
in traping out water casks and stowing them
back again

Remarks Wednesday November 2nd
Employed in stowing down water casks later
part running water and sheathing the deck

Remarks Thursday November 3rd
Employed in running water from the water boat
112 casks later part employed in fiddling the
fore top gallin mast seawards

Remarks Friday November 4th
Employed in clearing up later part
doing nothing seawards

Remarks Saturday November 5th
First part doing nothing later part
getting provisions on board seawards 24 casks

Remarks Sunday November 6th
Employed in getting wood on board later part
men on shore seawards this day

Remarks Monday November 7th
First part men on shore later part stowing
down provisions and lard casks provisions 24 casks

Remarks Tuesday November 8th
Clearing up deck seawards

Remarks Wednesday November 9th
Got one boat from the Crezenbo later part
doing nothing seawards

Remarks Thursday November 10th
Doing nothing later part the same

Remarks Friday November 11th
Doing nothing later part hauling ship

Remarks on board Ship, Majestic Saturday November 12th 1859

Employed in getting ready for sea, men came
on board 12 forward 6 in the steerage at 1 Pm
the steamer took us outside with light and
baffling wind and rain middle and later
part light wind from the S E heading
on with tack laying of and on Honolulu
at 11 Am. made all sail standing to the S E
under the same. took out provisions

Sat none Song none
Remarks Sunday November 13th
Came in with moderate wind from the
S E heading on with tack shielded and
later part the same seawards

Sat none Song none
Remarks Monday November 14th
Came in with moderate wind from the
S E heading on with all sail middle
and later part the same employ
in the rigging saw on shore seawards

Sat 24 25 Song none
Remarks Tuesday November 15th
Came in with moderate wind from the
S E heading on with all sail at 11 Pm
hand top gallin sail, rain squalls later
part the same employed in clearing up again
seawards

Sat 24 25 Song 150 182
Remarks Wednesday November 16th
Came in with strong wind from the S E
heading on under top sails at 5 Pm set
top gallin sail, took out bread middle
and later part squally at 10 Pm and top
gallin sail seawards

Sat 26 13 Song none
Remarks Thursday November 17th
Came in with strong wind from the S E
heading on with top sails employ in
making spinnaker at 3 Pm made all sail
later part the same
