

Remarks on board Ship the *Majestic* Friday November 18th 1857

Come in with moderate wind from the E. & head-
ing it with all sail employed in painting boats
and making spun yarn. Later part wind veer
to the E. & heading it & light in that sail
employed in making spun yarn some ends.

Lat 34° 25' Long 158° 45'

Remarks Saturday November 19th
Come in with light wind from the E. &
heading it & light in that sail put one
boat on the east crane, and took one in
middle and later part light wind from
the eastward heading to the northward.

Lat 34° 45' Long 158° 26'

Remarks Sunday November 20th
Come in with light wind and baffling
middle and later part squally from all
points of the compass at 5 P.M. hand top
gallin sails some ends brok out meat.

Lat 34° 30' Long 159° 17'

Remarks Monday November 21st
Come in with rain squally and baffling
wind from the E. heading to the E. & heading
top sails at 7 P.M. set main top gallin sail
middle part the same ends squally from the E.
heading at 1 P.M. brok out water employed in
getting out a flying jib boom some ends.

Lat 32° 45' Long 159° 16'

Remarks Tuesday November 22nd
Come in with strong wind and squally from
the E. heading at 1 P.M. with main top gallin
sail at 7 P.M. took it in again at 3 P.M.
2 reef the top sails and the same.

Remarks Wednesday November 23rd
Come in with strong wind from the E. heading
at 1 P.M. with 2 reef top sails at set main
derates set hole top sails employed in getting
out mizen top mast some ends.

Lat 35° 02' Long none

Remarks on board Ship the *Majestic* Thursday November 24th 1857

Come in with light wind from the E. then
veer to the S. steering E. by E at 2 P.M. made
all sail employed in sending out flying
jib boom and bending the flying jib at 1 P.M.
wind veer to the S. and baffling some ends.

Lat 35° 10' Long 158° 13'

Remarks Friday November 25th
Come in with light wind and baffling
from the S. steering E. by E with all sail
at 7 P.M. wind veer to the S. & later part
employed in painting boats some ends.

Lat 34° 35' Long 148° 18'

Remarks Saturday November 26th
Come in with light wind from the N.
steering E. by E with all sail employed
in getting rigging at 10 P.M. wind veer
to the E. & heading S. with all sail
later part employed in sail mending.

Lat 33° 40' Long 146° 21'

Remarks Sunday November 27th
Come in with strong wind from the E. &
heading S. on the bar board took at 7 P.M.
took in top gallin sails and flying
jib at 11 P.M. tacked ship to the S.
at 11 P.M. set main top gallin sail and
flying jib same sail brok out provisioning.

Lat 33° 45' Long none

Remarks Monday November 28th
Come in with strong wind from the
E. & heading at 1 P.M. middle and later part
the same employed in sending down mizen
top mast and the yards some ends.

Lat 34° 23' Long none

Remarks Tuesday November 29th
Come in with moderate wind from the E. &
heading at 1 P.M. veer to the E. & heading at 1 P.M.
employed in sending up a new mizen top mast
later part employed in a gift to sail.

Lat 36° 46' Long 142° 37'
