

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Wednesday December 1<sup>st</sup> 1857

Come in with moderate wind from the ESE heading E at 8 P.M. hand top gallin sails and flying jib at 10 P.M. reef the top sails. later part the same

Lat 37° 40' Long 142° 46'

Remarks Thursday December 2<sup>nd</sup> 1857  
Come in with strong wind from the ESE heading on both tacks at 5 P.M. reef the top sails and hand the jib and main sail middle and later part the same southerly

Lat 38° 36' Long 142° 07'

Remarks Friday December 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Come in with fresh gale from the ESE with draft top sails heading on both tacks

X middle part the same at 10 P.M. moderate at 10 P.M. top sails one man fell from the fore top sail yard in shaking out the reef and broke his leg and arm

Lat 38° 05' Long 142° 00'

Remarks Saturday December 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Come in with strong wind and rain from the ESE heading E under top sails and cross jib and spanker at 8 P.M. reef the top sails at 10 P.M. moderate at 10 P.M. top sail at 10 P.M. made all sail bent the gaff top sail southerly

Lat 38° 40' Long 140° 47'

Remarks Sunday December 4<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light wind from the ESE then SE heading E with all sail middle and later part wind light and baffling same in tacks

Lat 37° 45' Long 139° 53'

Remarks Monday December 5<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with moderate wind from the ESE heading on both tacks middle and later part the same broke meat

Lat 37° 55' Long 138° 55'

Remarks on board Ship Majestic Tuesday December 6<sup>th</sup> 1857

Come in with strong wind and squally from the ESE heading on both tacks at 2 P.M. tack in top gallin sails middle and later part under top sails at 5 P.M. wind veered to the SSE heading E ends the same

Lat 37° 00' Long 138° 28'

Remarks Wednesday December 7<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with strong wind and squally from the SSE heading E at 2 P.M. split the jib and sent it in at 3 P.M. bent a new jib at 4 P.M. set top gallin sails and flying jib and gaff top sail employed in sail mending southerly

Lat 38° 50' Long 135° 47'

Remarks Thursday December 8<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with strong wind from the SSE heading E with all sail at 3 P.M. hand top gallin sails employed in sail mending caught one spar hawk middle and later part light more moderate southerly

Lat 38° 45' Long none

Remarks Friday December 9<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with moderate wind from the SSE heading E with top sails at 2 P.M. made all sail middle and later part the same employed in repairing the windluffs

Lat 38° 40' Long 134° 35'

Remarks Saturday December 10<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light wind and baffling heading on both tacks broke all molasses middle and later part light wind and calm employed in sail mending southerly

Lat 38° 30' Long 134° 26'

Remarks Sunday December 11<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with calm and light baffling wind from all points of the compass southerly
