

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Sunday December 25th 1857

Come in with light wind from the S.W. steering E. with all sail at 4 P.M. let go the starboard anchor under Cape Blanco in 4 fms. of water with 35 fms. of chain middle part the same later part 2 bits went down to the fath lagoon sounds

Remarks Monday December 26th
Come in pleasant laying at anchor under Cape Blanco at 4 P.M. the boat came on board middle part light wind from the S.W. at 3 P.M. parted the port chain 10

fms. from the anchor and lost the anchor made all sail and stood S.W. by E. 11 some news

Lat 23° 49' Long none

Remarks Tuesday December 27th
Come in with light wind from the S.W. steering S.W. by E. with all sail at 7 P.M. saw island bearing S.W. by E. 5 miles distant main land bearing S.W. by E. 11 at 3 P.M. wind veered to the S.W. and blowing strong beating up between snags and tumbled sounders

Remarks Wednesday December 28th
Come in with strong wind strong wind strong wind from the S.W. heading on both tacks at 4 P.M. steering E. with all sail at 7 P.M.

let go the starboard anchor in 5 fms. of water with 35 fms. of chain at 6 P.M. hove in both boats and went outside whaling got nothing sounders this 24 hours

Remarks Thursday December 29th
Come in with strong wind from the S.W. employed in chasing whales came on board at 3 P.M. at 4 P.M. weighed anchor and went out of the bay then running along the land steering E. S. E. with all sail set later part light wind broke out

Remarks on board ship *Majestic* Friday December 30th 1857

Come in with light wind from the S.W. steering E. with all sail at 4 P.M. of Assention Island then steering E. later part heading on the wind

Remarks Saturday December 31st
Come in with light wind from the S.W. heading on both tacks at 4 P.M. came to anchor in Calenas Bay in 5 fms. of water with 35 fms. of water with 30 fms. of chain later part employed in sounding out the passage sounders

Remarks Sunday January 1st 1858
Employed in sounding out the passage broke out bread later part killed one hog

Remarks Monday January 2nd
Come in with strong wind from the S.W. laying at anchor in Calenas Bay middle and later part the same

Remarks Tuesday January 3rd
Come in with light wind from the S.W. laying at anchor at 3 P.M. light wind from the S.W. at 4 P.M. weighed anchor and went down the coast 20 miles sounders

Remarks Wednesday January 4th
Come in at 1 P.M. light wind from the S.W. at 2 P.M. came to anchor & boat went ashore came on board at 5 P.M. at 6 P.M. light wind from the S.W. weighed anchor and ran back into Calenas Bay and let go the anchor in 5 fms. of water with 30 fms. of chain sounders broke out flour
