

Remarks on board Park Majesty Thursday January 5th 1860

Come in with light wind and rain from the SE
laying at anchor at 3 PM boats came on
board at 6 PM and 4 boats employed in
chasing whale under the same.

Remarks Friday January 6th
Come in with chasing whale at 2 PM
wind veering to the SE with rain
at 4 PM boats came on board took out
water later part light wind from the SE
the Henry Knutland got under way at 6 PM
and went in to the passage with 4 boats
ahead at 3 PM struck on the bar and stopp
ed went to have with 4 boats but could not do
any good at 1 PM whale and went on to
Mer and store the how boat had

Remarks Saturday January 7th
Come in with light wind from the SE
employed in chasing whale got nothing
at 4 PM came on board at 6 PM put 4
boats on the how ran at 1 PM and
3 boats and went to the Henry Knutland
with strong SE wind came on board at 1 PM

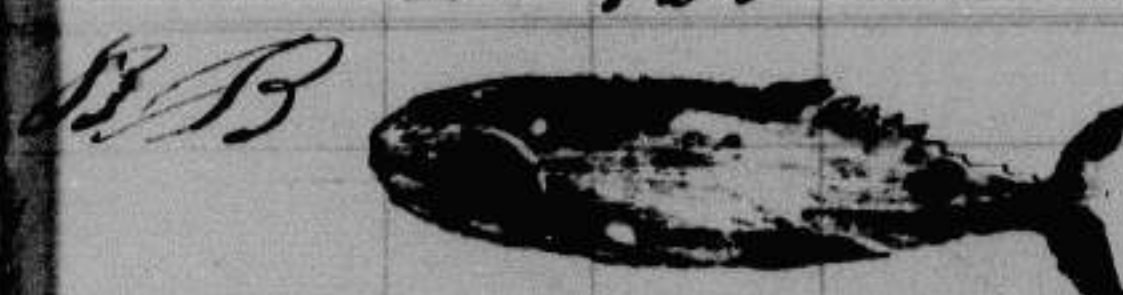
Remarks Sunday January 8th
Come in with strong wind from the SE
reaping the storm boat later part one
boat went in to help to the Henry
Knutland of showing to her anchor some

Remarks Monday January 9th
Come in with light wind from the SE
laying at anchor boats came on board at 5 PM
took out meat at 10 PM weighed anchor
and went down the coast steering SE by S with
all sail set saw 2 sail 
Sat 25000 Song none

Remarks on board Park Majesty Tuesday January 10th 1860

Come in with moderate wind from the SE steering
SE by S with all sail at 1 PM left to the
wind with the main yard aback heading on
boath: back at 6 PM left an oystering 4 with
all sail at 6 PM past the head land and went
into Margaret Bay some

Remarks Wednesday January 11th
Come in with strong wind from the SE
steering different courses at 3 PM came to anchor in
5 fms of water with 15 fms of chain 3 ships
at anchor lost to at 6 PM and 4 boats for a whale
at 7 PM how boat struck and saved rip sack kilo
unknown employed in towing



Remarks Thursday January 12th
First part employed in towing whale at
1 PM took her alongside and went in
at 6 PM and 4 boats and with chasing whale

Remarks Friday January 13th
Come in with chasing whale boats came
on board at 5 PM employed in boiling cord
3 boats at 6 PM and chased through the
bay some this 24 hours

Remarks Saturday January 14th
First part employed in chasing whale boats
came on board at 5 PM with strong wind from
the SE and 4 boats at 6 PM at 6 PM how
boat struck and lost her after running 4 hours
the second mate being hurt and hurt him

Remarks Sunday January 15th
Boats came on board at 5 PM got nothing later
part doing nothing

Remarks Monday January 16th
Come in with doing nothing at 1 PM men unday
with the how boat and the 3 boats steering sea
ter and 2 men forward and 4 boats at 6 PM for whale
