

Remarks on board Bark Magister Friday March 16th 1860

First part one watch on shore employed in scrubbing ship later part took on board 10 blks of potatoes

Remarks Saturday March 17th

First part employed in coal taring later part scrubbing ship

Remarks Sunday March 18th

Employed in making ship later part men on shore

Remarks Monday March 19th

First part men on shore later part took on board 10 blks of potatoes

Remarks Tuesday March 20th

Came in with strong wind from the N.E. got under way and went outside. there of laying off and on later part the same

Sat 41:14 Long

Remarks Wednesday March 21st

Came in with strong wind from the N.E. with reefed topsails at 4 P.M. Captain came on board at 5 P.M. steering all till at 5 P.M. steering all with all sail at 10 P.M. reefed the topsails then steering all till at 2 P.M. steering all till and the same

Sat 42:01

Remarks Thursday March 22nd

Came in with strong wind from the N.E. steering all till with 2 reefed topsails gamming with the Omega saw the land at 10 P.M. at 6 P.M. steering all till with middle part the same at 8 P.M. more moderate shook the reef out the topsails sawed

Sat 43:37 Long 152:54

Remarks on board Bark Magister Friday March 23rd 1860

Came in with moderate wind from the N.E. steering all till with topsails at 3 P.M. steering all till middle and later part the same at 4 P.M. set more top gallin sail and flying jib gamming with the Omega broke bit water took the starboard boat and deck and nailed her

Sat 44:39 Long 160:20

Remarks Saturday March 24th

Came in with strong wind from the N.E. steering all till with more top gallin sail at 6 P.M. hauld more top gallin sail and reefed the topsails middle and later part the same saw sail

Sat 45:25 Long 161:35

Remarks Sunday March 25th

Came in with strong wind from the N.E. steering all till with reefed topsails sent down fore top mast studding sail boom middle and later part squally sawed

Sat 47:00 Long 163:13

Remarks Monday March 26th

Came in with strong wind and squally from the N.E. steering all till with reefed topsails at 5 moderate shook the reef out of the topsails middle part the same at 8 P.M. set top gallin sail and flying jib later part rain squally from the N.E. gamming with the Omega sawed

Sat 48:19 Long 164:24

Remarks Tuesday March 27th

Came in with moderate wind from the N.E. steering all till with all sail at 5 P.M. steering all till middle and later part the same

Sat 49:14 Long 165:23

Remarks Wednesday March 28th

Came in light and baffling wind from the N.E. steering all till with all sail at 5 P.M. steering all till saw one sail on bent and bent the foresail later part went to the studding sails and stowed them away

Sat 50:30 Long 167:47
