

Remarks on Board Bark the Majestic Tuesday April 17th 1860

Came in with strong wind from the N heading
Sail with topsails, saw black fish growing
quick middle and later part light wind and
baffling seaward this 24 hours

Lat 38° 31' Long 109° 02'

Remarks Wednesday April 18th
Came in with light wind and baffling on the
starboard tack middle part calm at 5 PM
light wind from the S steering all half
with all sails employed in the rigging

Lat 37° 56' Long 102° 57'

Remarks Thursday April 19th
Came in with moderate wind from the S
steering all half with all sail middle and
later part the same employed in the rigging
hooked provisions seaward

Lat 37° 25' Long none

Remarks Friday April 20th
Came in with light wind from the S
steering all half with all sail middle part
the same later part rain and foggy
at 11 PM calm seaward hooked water

Lat none Long none

Remarks Saturday April 21st
Came in calm at 5 PM light wind from
the S heading all half with all
sails on the starboard tack aboard middle and
later part light wind and baffling parted
the fore top gallin stay employed in setting
it again seaward

Lat 37° 33' Long 108° 45'

Remarks Sunday April 22nd
Came in with light wind and calm employed
in the rigging at 3 PM light wind from the
S heading all half with all sail on the
port tack middle and later part the same

Lat 40° 40' Long 154° 05'

Remarks on Board Bark the Majestic Monday April 23rd 1860

Came in with moderate wind from the S heading
all half with all sail at 3 PM arrived
from the S steering all half Sat 4 PM had
major and mizen top masts staysail and
flying jib part top gallin sail at 2 PM heavy
squalls hard mane top gallin sail and jib mane
sail spanker fore top sail and reef the mane
top sail and hove to heading all half ends
with heavy gale

Remarks Tuesday April 24th
Came in with heavy gale from the S heading to
with 3 reef mane top sail at 3 PM moderate
set top sail at 5 PM made all sail wind veering
to the N heading all half middle and later
part calm employed in sorting potatoes

Remarks Wednesday April 25th
Came in with calm employed in sorting potato
saw fin back at 2 PM light wind
from the S heading all half with
all sail later part the same seaward

Lat 41° 05' Long 151° 10'

Remarks Thursday April 26th
Came in with moderate wind from the
S heading all half with all sail at 6 PM
wind veering to the S steering all half
middle and later part the same employed in
ing thick fog seaward

Lat 41° 57' Long 148° 45'

Remarks Friday April 27th
Came in with light from the S steering all half
with all sail at 8 PM calm at 9 PM light wind
from the S steering all half thick fog middle
and later part the same wind light and baffling
seaward
