

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Saturday April 23rd 1860

Came in with thick fog and light wind and baffling middle and later part the same broke out water
Lat 40° 45' Long none

Remarks Sunday April 29th
Came in with light wind and baffling from all points of the compass middle and later part the same pleasant.
Lat 40° 36' Long 149° 25'

Remarks Monday April 30th
Came in calm at 3 PM light wind from the E steering off by S with all sail at 2 PM came to the wind with more yards back later part thick fog heading to the S E at 11 PM calm southerly
Lat 40° 54' Long 149° 59'

Remarks Tuesday May 1st 1860
Came in with calm and thick fog with a heavy swell heading to the S middle and later part the same southerly
Lat 40° 26' Long 149° 57'

Remarks Wednesday May 2nd
Came in with light wind and baffling heading on with tacks with thick fog at 5 PM fog cleared up with calm middle and later part the same broke out provisions
Lat 40° 16' Long 149° 32'

Remarks Thursday May 3rd
Came in with light air from the S steering off by S with all sail middle and later part the same at 5 PM saw the land. Carrying the S distant 40 ms ~~Shales of Japan~~
Lat 40° 23' Long 149° 11'

Remarks Friday May 4th
Came in with light wind from the S steering off by S with all sail at 1 PM wind veering to the S with heavy squalls hand to top of the sails flying jib, aft, fore sail and reef the top sails to the main sail at 5 PM hand the fore top sail and reef the main and the jib at 11 PM moderate at 5 PM made all sail wind veering to the S steering off by S southerly
Lat 40° 10' Long 149° 15'

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Saturday May 5th 1860

Came in with light wind from the S steering off by S with all sail bent the main sail and rose on hunting at 3 PM steering off by S middle and later part calm saw the land
Lat 40° 35' Long 149° 26' E

Remarks Sunday May 6th
Came in with calm at 3 PM light wind from the S steering off by S with all sail middle and later part calm in the straits of Sangar saw a number of junk, kept the S at 5 PM southerly ~~Sangar or Shalima straits~~
Lat 40° 25' Long 149° 30' E

Remarks Monday May 7th
Came in with calm at 1 PM light wind from the E steering off by S with all sail middle and later part calm southerly
Lat none Long none

Remarks Tuesday May 8th
Came in with calm at 1 PM strong wind from the S heading on with tacks with 5 miles current running to the southward at 2 PM bent the star board anchor at 4 PM came to anchor in 25 fms of water with 35 fms of chain with the port anchor land 1/2 mile at 1 PM light wind from the E veered anchor and got under way steering off by S with all sail at 2 PM lost 3 boats for night whale yawning quick southerly
Lat none Long none

Remarks Wednesday May 9th
Came in with moderate wind from the E steering off by S with all sail boats came on board at 1 PM at 6 PM got the anchor on the bow and unbent the star board chain in the Japanese sea, later part wind from the S steering off by S seven broke out water
Lat none Long none
