

Remarks on board Park Majestic Saturday June 16<sup>th</sup> 1860

Come in with light wind from the S<sup>W</sup> steering  
E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E with all sail employed in said mending at 10<sup>30</sup>  
thick fog later part the same same ends

Remarks Sunday June 17<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with thick fog and light wind from  
the S<sup>W</sup> steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E under top sails at 7<sup>30</sup>  
came to the wind with main & top sail aback  
heading S<sup>W</sup> E middle part the same at 9<sup>15</sup> in  
steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> S with all sail foggy by spells

Remarks Monday June 18<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light wind from the S<sup>W</sup>  
steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E with all sail foggy by spells  
middle and later part the same same ends

Sat 48:22 A Song 196:34 E

Remarks Tuesday June 19<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light winds from the S<sup>W</sup> steering  
E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E at 3<sup>30</sup> fog cleared up saw the land  
with steering to the S<sup>W</sup> steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E with all sail  
at 10<sup>30</sup> towards ship to the S<sup>W</sup> middle and later  
part heading on loath tacks with thick fog  
broke on to the same ends

Remarks Wednesday June 20<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light and lapping winds with  
thick fog saw what land bore 2 boats at 6<sup>30</sup>  
came on board at 8<sup>30</sup> without such sep. middle  
and later part foggy the wind from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks saw the land

Remarks Thursday June 21<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with moderate wind from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks under top sails foggy  
by spells middle part the same later part  
steering spoke the Chilesell & Baxin saw the  
land made all sail

Remarks on board Park Majestic Friday June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1860

Come in with moderate wind from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks with all sail employed  
in making running rigging out of old cut being  
falls late part the same same ends this 24 hours  
saw the land bearing E distant 10 miles

Remarks Saturday June 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Come in with moderate wind from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks middle and later part  
the same same the land

Sat 45:58 Song none

Remarks Sunday June 24<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light wind from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
then steering to the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E heading on loath tacks  
at 1<sup>30</sup> saw hump back and 4 boats and  
chandeliers at 6<sup>30</sup> without such sep. middle  
and later part light winds from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks beating through the  
strates of Beryces

Remarks Monday June 25<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light winds from the E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E  
heading on loath tacks middle part beat in  
later part light wind from the S<sup>W</sup> steering  
with all sail foggy by spells saw the land

Remarks Tuesday June 26<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with moderate wind from the S<sup>W</sup>  
steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E with all sail middle  
and later part the same same ends

Sat 46:17 Song none

Remarks Wednesday June 27<sup>th</sup>  
Come in with light winds from the S<sup>W</sup>  
steering E<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E with all sail under running  
to the S<sup>W</sup> at 5<sup>30</sup> steering in at E with all sail  
at 8<sup>30</sup> bore 4 boats for feet back got nothing  
came on board at 8<sup>30</sup> middle and later part  
light winds and lapping with fog and  
rain same ends
