

Remarks on board Bark the Justic Thursday June 25<sup>th</sup> 1860

Came in with light wind and baffling ~~from~~  
heading on both tacks middle and later  
part moderate wind from the E heading  
at 11 with all sail employ in sail mending

Remarks Friday June 27<sup>th</sup>

Came in with moderate wind from the E  
heading at 8 with all sail employ in sail  
mending middle part wind strengthens hard  
top gale in sails at 4 PM haul jib and  
mainail and reef the topsails at 7  
AM haul fore sail and fore topsail blow  
ing heavy with rain at 5 PM secured ship  
to the S end the with a gal

Remarks Saturday June 30<sup>th</sup>

Came in with fresh gale from the E  
laying to with reef main topsail head  
ing to the S at 9 AM wind ship at  
3 PM wind veering to the S E secured ship  
to the E at 4 PM more moderate set the  
fore sail and fore topsail reef spanker  
and jib and main staysail seawards

Remarks Sunday July 1<sup>st</sup> 1860

Came in with fresh gale from the S E  
heading to the East reef topsails at  
2 PM gale strengthens haul the jib and span  
ker middle part the same later part moder  
ates set the jib and spanker and reef top  
sails broke out meat seawards

Remarks Monday July 2<sup>nd</sup>

Came in with strong wind with reef top  
sails from the S heading to the S middle  
and later part the same employ in running  
set trawl down the main hatch heading on  
both tacks under topsails seawards

Remarks on board Bark the Justic Tuesday July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1860

Came in with moderate wind from the N by N  
heading on both tacks employ in running set trawl  
down the main hatch middle and later part  
thick fog with light winds and veering to the N

Remarks Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup>

Came in with light winds from the S then  
veering to the S E heading to the S by S middle  
and later part the same gale with the  
Topsy saw the land Cape Point

Lat 49:00 Long 145:05

Remarks Thursday July 5<sup>th</sup>

Came in with light winds from the S E  
then veering to the S heading to the S  
N with all sail land distant 10 m bearing  
all middle and later part heading on both  
tacks saw the land Robinson

Lat 48:40 Long 144:42 E

Remarks Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>

Came in with light wind from the S E  
heading on both tacks at 2 PM about  
went in shore to Robinson island killing seal  
came on board at 10 PM with 4 skins middle  
part laying a back later part heading  
on both tacks employ in getting out  
cask and cooping them seawards

Remarks Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup>

Came in with light wind from the S  
heading on both tacks at 2 PM sent 4  
boat in shore with cask the 2 mates and  
3 men and provisions boat came on board  
at 3 PM steering E by S under topsails mid  
dle and later part the same at 11 PM wind  
veering to the S seawards

Came in with light winds from the N by N  
E by S at 11 PM came to the wind heading to the N  
skid all and later part wind light and baffling
