

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Wednesday August 29th 1860

Came in with light wind, from the N.W. heading on board tacks with thick fog middle and later part the same with a calm breeze

Remarks Thursday August 30th
Came in with a calm and thick fog at 2 1/2 p.m. saw the land distant 15 miles bearing E. later part light wind from the S.W. with thick fog heading on board tacks

Remarks Friday August 31st
Came in with thick fog and rain from the S.W. heading on board tacks middle and later part thick fog saw a whale at 5 p.m. and Lord 4 boats at 6 p.m. started and boat struck whale running head saw and

Remarks Saturday September 1st
Came in with light wind and fog from the N.W. at 3 p.m. at the line at 4 p.m. went on board the ship at 4 p.m. came on board middle part wind light and baffling later part moderate wind from the N.W. at 5 p.m. saw a whale and Lord 3 boats at 10 p.m. came on board got nothing at 11 p.m. blowing strong hard top gallies sails flying jib gaff topsails and hand the main sail saw the land 5 sail

Remarks Sunday September 2nd
Came in with strong wind from the N.W. heading on board tacks under topsails at 2 p.m. saw a whale and Lord 3 boats waste boat struck whale ran head at 5 p.m. cut the line came on board at 4 p.m. middle and later part fresh gales with reef topsails and reef jib and spanker saw the land distant 30 miles bearing E.S.E.

Lat 50° 54' Long 154° 48' E

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Monday September 3rd 1860

Came in with fresh gales from the N.W. heading on board tacks with reef topsails reef jib and spanker with heavy cross sea middle part more moderate later part made all sail heading on board tacks saw 3 sail

Lat 50° 58' Long none

Remarks Tuesday September 4th
Came in with moderate winds from the N.W. heading to the N.W. with all sail at 3 p.m. saw a whale and Lord 4 boats came on board at 5 p.m. got nothing middle and later part thick fog saw a whale and Lord 3 boats at 7 p.m. came on board at 10 p.m. got nothing wind veering to the N.W. and blowing strong hard top gallies sails and flying jib split the jib and sent it to land bent a new one succeeded

Lat 51° 08' Long 154° 55' E

Remarks Wednesday September 5th
Came in with strong winds from the N.W. heading on board tacks under topsails saw a whale and Lord 3 boats at 2 p.m. came on board at 4 p.m. got nothing Lord 3 boats at 5 p.m. came on board at 8 p.m. got nothing middle part came at 7 p.m. Lord 4 boats for a whale and chased through the day

Remarks Thursday September 6th
Came in with a calm employed in chipping a whale came on board at 3 p.m. got nothing middle part strong winds from the N.E. reefed the topsails and hoisted the jib and main sail at 10 p.m. more moderate and all sail saw the land distant 35 miles bearing E. saw 2 sail broke out water
