

Remarks on Board Bark Majestic Friday September 7th 1860

Came in with moderate winds from the N E heading on with all sail set in both masts middle and late part moderate saw whale at 5:00 am and took 4 boats at 10:00 am starboard boat struck after running 3 hours killed him broke the larboard boats steering gear and said ship was in striking danger the larboard boat mid ship in striking danger at 11:00 am turned up saw ends

Remarks Saturday September 8th 1860
Came in with moderate winds from the N E working the ship to windward for the whale at 2:00 pm took him along side at 4:00 pm commenced to cut in took his head gear and let him lay for the night at 5:00 pm commenced to cut at 11:00 pm got through saw ends saw sail

Remarks Sunday September 9th 1860
Came in with light winds from the N E heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in clearing up decks at 7:00 am commenced to haul middle and late part calm saw ends

Remarks Monday September 10th 1860
Came in with calm employed in hauling saw whale and took 4 boats at 2:00 pm came aboard at 6:00 pm got nothing 8 men with the scumy middle and late part light wind and baffling saw whale and took 4 boats at 5:00 pm came on board at 9:00 pm got nothing but 2 boats at 11:00 am took 10 men boat went on and rest came on board at 11:00 pm broke the boat steerer and made another saw ends saw the land

Remarks Tuesday September 11th 1860
Came in with light and baffling winds took 2 boats for whale at 1:00 pm starboard boat went on and struck and line parted lost him middle and late part light wind from the N heading on with all sail

Remarks on Board Bark Majestic Wednesday September 12th 1860

Came in with light winds from the N heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in hauling saw whale and took 2 boats at 3:00 pm came on board at 7:00 pm got nothing middle and late part light winds from the S heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in hauling down oil in the main hatch ends the same

Remarks Thursday September 13th 1860
Came in with light winds from the S heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in hauling down oil 133 blubs at 9:00 pm winds veering to the S E heading on with all sail set in both masts with rain later part cleared up

Remarks Friday September 14th 1860
Came in with strong winds from the S E heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in hauling line jice 18 men with the scumy middle and late part fog at 11:00 am wind veering to the N heading on with all sail set in both masts with 2 reef topsails and strong winds saw whales and took 2 boats at 3:00 pm ends the same

Remarks Saturday September 15th 1860
Came in with strong winds from the N heading on with all sail set in both masts employed in hauling line jice 18 men with the scumy middle and late part fog at 11:00 am wind veering to the N heading on with all sail set in both masts with 2 reef topsails and strong winds saw whales and took 2 boats at 3:00 pm ends the same

Lat 51° 20' N Long 15° 50' W

Remarks Sunday September 16th 1860
Came in with thick fog and baffling winds employed in running salt water in the main hatch middle and late part moderate wind from the N heading on with all sail set in both masts saw the land
