

Remarks on board Bark *Majestic* Monday September 17th 1860

Came in with moderate winds from the N. heading on board tack, saw whale having quick Lord boat, at 2 PM came on board at 8 PM got nothing at 7 PM swept the topsails, blowing fresh gale middle part the same with heavy squalls at 10 PM more moderate at shoak the reefant the topsails saw the land bearing E distant 15 miles

Lat 34° 16' Long 155° 17'

Remarks Tuesday September 18th Came in with strong winds from the N. heading on board tack, under topsail, at 1 PM made all sail middle and later part the same at 4 PM wind veering to the N. heading all by 8 saw no land

Lat 34° 11' Long none

Remarks Wednesday September 19th Came in with strong winds from the N. heading all by 8 with all sail at 1 PM hand top gallies sails and flying jib and top sails saw whale and Lord boat at 10 AM at 3 PM came on board got nothing swept the topsails at 5 PM fresh gales swept the topsails reef jib and spanker and hand the maresail at 8 PM more moderate made sail topsails jib and main sail ends the same same sail

Lat 34° 27' Long 155° 03' E

Remarks Thursday September 20th Came in with moderate winds from the N. heading on board tack, under topsails at 5 PM light winds from the N. middle and later part calm employed in running salt water saw 2 sail saw the land bearing E by 15 miles

Lat 34° 53' Long 155° 36'

Remarks Friday September 21st Came in with calm at 2 PM light wind from the S. steering E at 4 PM sent Lord boat for champagne came on board at 4 PM got nothing middle and later part strong winds heading on board tack under topsails spoke the ship kilman, hazy

Lat 34° 00' Long 155° 33'

Remarks on board Bark *Majestic* Saturday September 22nd 1860

Came in with strong winds from the S heading on board tack under topsails middle part the same at 6 PM made all sail at 8 PM carried away flying jib and jibgyes and black ropes sent out a new black rope and set up the jibgyes again at 11 PM swept the topsails hand top gallies sails and flying jib and veering to the S. E. saw no land

Lat none Long none

Remarks Sunday September 23rd Came in with strong winds from the S. heading S. with swept topsails at 7 PM swept the topsails hand main sail and jib and spanker at 9 PM hand fore topsail middle part the same at 6 PM wind veering to the N. at 7 PM set fore topsail with 1 reef more the same steering S. with rain and squally

Lat none Long none

Remarks Monday September 24th Came in with fresh gales from the N. steering S. with swept topsails at 2 PM hand fore topsail and fore sail swept the main topsail making heavy at 7 PM gale winged the main topsail at 8 PM set the main sail moderate at 6 PM set the fore sail and swept fore topsail at 8 PM steering S. with all sail employed in getting up bedding sails two men saw no land this 24 hours wind veering to S. by

Lat 49° 07' Long 152° 48' E

Remarks Tuesday September 25th Came in with strong wind from the S. steering S. with all sail at 3 PM saw the land and set the top mast and fore studding sails middle and later part the same fog wind veering to the S. by at 4 PM steering S. by at 7 PM hove in studding sails 11 men with the scurvy at 11 PM made up

Lat 47° 45' Long 155° 01' E
