

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Wednesday September 26th 1860

Came in with strong winds from the N. steering E. with all sail employed in knotting yarns and sawing shunt middle and late part strong winds employed in fitting fore brace penants and making spinnings and sawing this 24 hours

Lat 46° 12' Long 153° 30' E

Remarks Thursday September 27th
Came in with strong winds from the S. steering E. with all sail at 5 P.M. wind veering to the S. steering E. by S. hand fore top gallin sail and flying jib middle part the same at 3 P.M. moderate made all sail at 11 P.M. steering E. employed in fitting fore top gallant and fore top sail brace penants sawing

Lat 45° 15' Long 162° 22'

Remarks Friday September 28th
Came in with strong winds from the S. steering E. with all sail employed in making spun yarn middle part fog and rain at 10 A.M. hand main top flying jib fore top gallin sail at 3 P.M. swept the top sails hand main top gallin sail and main sail sawing

Remarks Saturday September 29th
Came in with strong winds from the S. steering E. with the reef top sails at 4 P.M. swept the top sails and hand the jib middle part the same at 3 P.M. wind veering to the N. steering E. made all sail employed in making spun yarn sawing this 24 hours

Lat 44° 36' Long 163° 57' E

Remarks Sunday September 30th
Came in with strong winds from the N. steering E. with all sail employed in fitting new back ropes middle and late part moderate sawing

Lat 44° 10' Long 171° 39'

Remarks on board Bark Majestic Monday October 1st 1860

Came in with moderate winds from the N. steering E. with all sail employed in knotting yarns and sawing shunt middle and late part moderate winds employed in fitting fore brace penants and making spinnings and sawing this 24 hours

Remarks Tuesday October 2nd
Came in with calm men employed in the rigging at 6 P.M. light winds from the E. heading S. with all sail at 8 P.M. wind veering to the N. hand top gallin sail and flying jib at 2 P.M. swept the top sails hand the jib and main sail and sawing her at 5 P.M. hand fore sail and fore top sail

swept the main blowing heavy gale wind veering to the N. laying on the port tack at 11 A.M. split the main spenceer hand main top sail and fore top mast staysail sawing

Remarks Wednesday October 3rd
Came in with heavy gale from the N. steering E. with the reef top sails at 5 P.M. swept the tiller lashed to the spar and put the rudder at 3 P.M. moderate set swept main top sail at 3 P.M. kept away steering E. set the fore top sail and foresail employed in making a new tiller spoke and water and meat sawing

Lat 43° 45' Long 175° 57' E

Remarks Thursday October 4th
Came in with strong winds from the N. steering E. with the fore top sail and foresail and swept main top sail employed in making a new tiller at 5 P.M. put on and made all sail middle and late part late part sail mending sawing

Lat 43° 54' Long 178° 41'

Remarks Friday October 5th
Came in with moderate winds from the N. steering E. with all sail employed in making spun yarn at 11 P.M. hand top gallin sail at 4 P.M. swept the top sails wind veering to the S. at 11 P.M. wing veering to the N. with the reef top sail

Lat 43° 30' Long 179° 10' E
