

Remarks on board Bark *Majestic* Saturday October 6th 1860

Came in with fresh gale from the N. steering E. with 3 reefed topsail at 2 P.M. but 2 reefed topsail. 4 men with the sewing 4 dangerous middle part more moderate at 2 P.M. made all sail at 5 P.M. and were in to the shell at 10 P.M. steering E. by the sound.

Lat 42° 38' Long 155° 08' W

Remarks Sunday October 7th

Came in with strong wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail middle part the same sound.

Lat 41° 28' Long none

Remarks Monday October 8th

Came in with moderate wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail middle part the same at 2 P.M. 2 reefed the topsails at 4 P.M. made all sail ends the same.

Lat 41° 30' Long 163° 52' W

Remarks Tuesday October 9th

Came in with strong wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail at 5 P.M. heavy squalls from the N. hand top gallin sail, and reefed the topsails steering E. S. E. at 10 P.M. more moderate at 2 P.M. set topsails and top gallin sails. Late part light wind from N. steering E. with all sail Cape Point permission sound.

Remarks Wednesday October 10th

Came in with light wind from the N. steering E. with all sail but a new main topsail at 6 P.M. wind veered to the N. at the studding sail at 7 P.M. and veering to the S. W. middle and late part the same employed in the rigging and pleasant.

Lat 39° 31' Long 164° 49' W

Remarks Thursday October 11th

Came in with light wind from the S. W. steering E. by the sound with all sail middle and late part the same employed in rattling down sound.

Lat 38° 41' Long 163° 18' W

Remarks on board Bark *Majestic* Sunday October 12th 1860

Came in with light wind from the S. W. steering E. with all sail employed in rattling down Cape Point head middle and late part light wind and puffing.

Lat 38° 18' Long 162° 21' W

Remarks Saturday October 13th

Came in with light wind and puffing employed in the rigging at 8 P.M. heavy squalls from the N. E. hand top gallin sails flying jib and jib. main sail and 3 reefed the topsails heading S. E. by E. at 9 P.M. moderate at made all sail Cape Point water sound.

Lat 37° 14' Long 160° 10' W

Remarks Sunday October 14th

Came in with light and puffing wind employed in running all water in the fore hole middle part light wind and calm at 1 P.M. light wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail sent up the main top gallin studding sail boom and set the studding sails sound.

Lat 36° 12' Long 158° 57' W

Remarks Monday October 15th

Came in with light wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail at 1 P.M. wind veering to the N. took in studding sail set 10 P.M. steering E. by the sound the same.

Lat 36° 42' Long 158° 31' W

Remarks Tuesday October 16th

Came in with strong wind from the N. steering E. by the sound with all sail at 1 P.M. steering E. S. E. middle and late part more moderate wind veering to the N. W. set the studding sails sound.

Lat 33° 32' Long 154° 47' W

Remarks Wednesday October 17th

Came in with moderate wind from the N. W. steering E. S. E. with all sail at 3 P.M. steering S. E. by S. 16 men sick middle and late part light wind veering from N. W. to E. employed in drying loam sound.

Lat 32° 30' Long 154° 10' W
