

Remarks on Board Bark Majestic Thursday October 18<sup>th</sup> 1860

Came in with light winds from the N E steering S by E with all sail at 5 PM took in studding sails middle and late part light wind and baffling with rain squalls some 6

Lat 31° 00' Long 84° 00' W

Remarks Friday October 19<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with light and baffling winds with rain squalls heading from S S E to S by E with all sail at 1 PM took in flying jib and gaff topsail mid and late part strong winds from the S by E heading S S E with all sail ship heading S E

Lat 30° 40' Long 82° 41'

Remarks Saturday October 20<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with strong winds from the S E heading on weather back middle part the same at 1 PM winds from the S E heading S by E with all sail ends the same at 10 PM 10 men sick

Lat 25° 50' N Long 89° 51' W

Remarks Sunday October 21<sup>st</sup>  
Came in with moderate winds from the S E heading S by E with all sail middle and late part the same some 24 hours

Lat 21° 00' Long 85° 00'

Remarks Monday October 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Came in with strong winds from the S E heading S by E with all sail at 1 PM wind from the E steering S S E mid late part the same

Lat 24° 55' Long 82° 11'

Remarks Tuesday October 23<sup>rd</sup>  
Came in with strong winds from the E steering S S E with all sail at 1 PM steering S middle and late part the same at 10 PM 10 men with the scurvy

Lat 22° 40' N Long 85° 45' W

Remarks Wednesday October 24<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with strong winds from the N E steering S at 3 PM steering S S E with all studding sails at 5 PM saw the land at 10 PM took the pilot of demon head some 6

Remarks on Board Bark Majestic Thursday October 25<sup>th</sup> 1860

Came in with strong winds from the N E heading ahead for the steamer at 1 PM took the steamer and went into the harbor later part men pilg in mooring ship

Remarks Friday October 26<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with scrubbing ship later part the same some 24 hours

Remarks Saturday October 27<sup>th</sup>  
Employed in scrubbing ship heavy rain later part men on shore

Remarks Sunday October 28<sup>th</sup>  
First part men on shore later part the same

Remarks Monday October 29<sup>th</sup>  
Men on shore later part the same

Remarks Tuesday October 30<sup>th</sup>  
Discharged the crew later part the same

Remarks Wednesday October 31<sup>st</sup>  
Doing nothing later part the same

Remarks Thursday November 1<sup>st</sup>  
First part doing nothing later part the same

Remarks Friday November 2<sup>nd</sup>  
First part doing nothing later part the same
