Come in with light wind from the N.W. steering S by E with all sail broke out meat to cook in the old boat and broke hump to cook in the new davits. middle and later part the same

Come in with light wind from the N.W. steering S by E with all sail employed in the rigging at 10 P.m. winds varying to the E. Hand the starboard studding sail at 8 o'clock winds varying to the E. Hand the starboard sail and set the jib soars and

Remarks Monday December 24th

Come in with light winds from the E. S. E heading S with all sail middle part the same at 8 o'clock winds varying to the E. Hand the studding sails ends the same

Come in with strong winds from the N. steering S by E with all sail at 3 P.m. hand the studding sails at 4 o'clock more moderate at the studding sails at 6 o'clock winds varying to the E. Hand the same employed in sail mending with the hole

Come in with moderate wind from the N. steering S by E with all sail employed in sail mending at 10 o'clock in middle and later part the same broke out water employed in sail mending

Come in with light and baffling wind employed in sail mending later part the same at 3 o'clock from the E. steering S with all sail

Come in with moderate winds from the E. S. E heading S with all sail at 8 o'clock winds varying to the S. E heading S. S. E employed in sail mending some wind pleasant

Remarks Saturday December 29th

Come in with moderate winds from the S. E heading S with all sail middle and later part calm employed in sail mending

Lat. 8° 25' Long. 161° 47'

Remarks Sunday December 30th

Come in with light wind from the S by E heading S with all sail at 3 P.m. strong wind hand flying jib and fore top gall in sail middle and later part light and baffling with squalls

Lat. 7° 45' Long. 161° 48'

Remarks Monday December 31st

Come in with light and baffling winds and squalls later part moderate wind from the E by S heading S by E with all sail some wind this 24 hours taking

Lat. 6° 30' Long. 161° 53' M

Remarks Tuesday January 1st 1861

Come in with moderate winds from the E by S heading S by E with all sail middle and later part light and baffling employed in washing some saws

Lat. 5° 15' Long. 161° 37'

Remarks Wednesday January 2nd

Come in with light and baffling winds middle and later part the same drying some

Lat. 5° 04' Long. 161° 36'

Remarks Thursday January 3rd

Come in with light wind and baffling employed in washing some middle and later part light and baffling employed in the rigging
