part light T Breeze from S and E. (Trades) Tacked
and stood to E. Saw nothing worthy of note. Co.

Saturday Cont. With light T Breeze and Clear weather and
Apr. 14 Standing to the S. Saw 1 Black fish coming and
got one took him along side and hoisted it in on
Deck. latter part wind light. So ends 24 hours.

Lat. 3.54. S. Long 84.31. West

Sunday Begins with light winds from E. Standing on the
Apr. 16 Wind to the N. & E. at 8 A.M. Saw a Sperm Standing
to the West at 12 noon saw a School of Black fish coming
3 T Boats and got 5 brought them aboard and got
them in on deck. latter part wind T Brisk & Cloudy.

Lat. 2.50 S. Long. 84.45 W.

Wednesday First part of this 48 No Light T Breeze from the East
Apr. 18 Standing to the S and E. Saw finback whales, and
1 Black fish latter part a Calm. at Sun set. Shortland.

Friday First part of this 48 No Brisk winds and
Apr. 20 Pleasant weather. Standing to the S. & W. Saw a
School finback whales at 1 P.M. Saw a Sperm
off our lee beam Standing to the S. & E. latter part is
light wind and clear sky. Began to day 51. 45. W.

Saturday Cont. With T Brisk Trades fr. S. & E. Standing
Apr. 21 to the S and W. at 9 A.M. Tacked and stood to the
S and E. Wind from S. latter part same. So ends

Lat. 3.15 S. Long 83.17 W.

Sunday Cont. With T Brisk winds and Pleasant weather
Apr. 22 Steering by wind to the Eastward at 9 A.M. Tacked
on. and stood part same. Saw nothing of note.

Monday Light Trades and Pleasant Steering by the wind
Apr. 23 to S. at 1 P.M. Tacked and stood to the W.
Saw 1 Hump and finback whales. Porpoises &c.
