Wednesday The Ship George & Susan going off and
May 6 On at Payton at 5 P. M. Inside on board
Laid Ship and Head to Sea. Spoke Ship
Crest of Wilmington inside Payton Point bound
In at 6 P. M. took in Light, Sails and Tumbled
Reefed Topsails. To End of Tide 24 hours.

Thursday (Cont.) With light Trades and pleasant weather
May 11 (Cont.) N. W. Saw 30 fish on N. & S. side.

June A.D. 1839

Saturday Light Winds from S. Standing to the N. & N. W.
Sun 10 A. M. Saw 30 fish off our bow
Boat kept off for them and at 12 towing our
Boat and the Harbour Quarter boat. Stuck &
The Harpoon crew at 1 P. M. all boats
Came on board and at 2- landed again. Whales
To land and the Lar. Gr. Boat and the Waste
Boat got fast. One Harpoon crew and on board
Sle the Boat Crew on board again. Saw Ship
and Head to the S and N. Latter part wind same

Thursday Fair last 5 days. With Trades and pleasant
Sun 17 Steering to the N. W. at Sun Set. Shortened Sail
and luffing to the wind. Saw nothing worthy of note

Friday (Cont.) With Light Trades Steering to the N. and N. W.
Sun 8 11 P. A. M. Saw 30 fish off our Starboard bow
At 12 landed and put out for them and at 3 P. M.
Came on board. Whales going to windward quick
At Sun Set in Shortened Sail and luffed up

Saturday Light Winds from S. and E. Steering to the N. W.
Sun 9 Saw nothing worthy of note. In dark Sailed for
Sailed light. Saw 30 fish double reefed Topsails
