July 29 To the S. and E. Calm part, blowing still hard
about 10 miles N. by N. E. Tacked Ship and stood
To the S and E. Lat 1.40 S. Long 84.58 W.

Friday These 2 last days. Strong breeze from S.E.
July 31 Standing on the wind to the E. Tacked and stood
To S. by E. on Monday Lat. S. Long W.

August - 1839

Wednesday Breeze With Pleasant Weather and Squally air
Aug 1. Fresh Standing to the S and E. beating to windward
Lat 1.50 S. Long 85.57 W.

Thursday Light Breeze Girth Girth, of these 3 days we
Aug 2. At Cruising to windward for whales. Saw 1st whale
at Sun. Set, Shortening Sail hands employed in this
Lat 5.38 S. Long W.

Friday Com^d With Moderate Breeze from S. Standing
Aug 10 To the S. and E. at 1 P.M. Saw a Whale off bow
on beam Standing to the S. at 5 P.M. Squared
on Main and Mizzen top Sails and ran down and
Spoke her. Old Ortolob of St. Croix 10 miles for the
Lat 4.10 S. Long 85.00 W.

Saturday Strong Winds from S. Standing by the wind to the E.
Aug 11 Middle Girth Same Sail as Day of our St.
Bore at 8 P.M. Spoke Ship Washington of
Charleston. Capt. Cann on board off us and
Lat. Vetter and Grapes. So ends this 24th

Sunday Com^d With Breeze Trades and Pleasant Standing to
Aug 12 To the S and E. Saw nothing worthy of note. Saw 1st whale
on top of S. and E. Lat. Same So ends 24th

Monday Strong Trades from S. Standing to the S. and E. at
Aug 13 12 Noon Spoke Whales as we thought, but afterwards proved
To be finback Whales. Saw a Sail Standing to the S.
At 4 P.M. Saw Spoke Whales a Drueking Lat 5.30
Ground our boat and the Carboard Quarter boat, got fast
and the Harpoon drew out at Sun down and on board

Tuesday Com^d With Cloudy Weather. Comm. S. by E. and S. by E.
Aug 14 At 4 P.M. Saw Spoke Whales off our bow at 6
Vermont and the Whist boat. Struck one small one
at 8 P.M. took him along side and laid with our fore
Solid and Cloud down and double reefed Main top Sail
with Main yard at each all night So ends 24th
Lat 4.10 S. Long 86.10 W.

Wednesday Light Winds and Pleasant at 9 A.M. Finished
Aug 15 Cutting and began to hoist. Made Sail and kept ship
off the S. by E. at 2 P.M. Saw Spoke Whales again
a Drueking off the beam kept ship for them at 4
Ground all the boats but, did not get any whales
Gallies and gone to the windward. So ends 24th

Thursday Light Winds from S. Standing on the wind to E.
Aug 16 Finished Boiling made 20 Bbls at 2 P.M. Saw
Spoke Whales a Drueking a Head at 3. Ground
the 4 boats and gave 1000 lbs the Carboard Quarter
Boats got, stood in a few minutes after leaving the
Ship by a Shark. he came on board and took
repaired the other boats kept on Chalk till the Whales
perceived the 1 boats and then they went quick to
the windward. Toats came on board and at Sun
Set took in Sight. Sail and double reefed top Sails

Saturday These 2 last days Light Trades and Pleasant, S.
Aug 18 Beating up to Chalk Island. Saw nothing worthy
of note. But - Black fish and Porpoises &c.
Hands employed in Ship duty - ends 48th
