Tuesday All hands but 2 employed ashore bringing down
Sept 4 Peruvian to the beach. Shee rather poor. Success on
Fox about 60. Bad within a few days for Spitzbergen
On Sunday a Spanish Sealer came and he got her
Anchored ahead and ashore of us. An English whaler
Ship Harpooners of London lying at the Point. We heard
by this Sealer - our Capt. Stepper on shore 2 nights -

Wednesday Oct 10 A.M. The Moon Shook, it being nearly a
Sept 5 Calm did not get underway until 11 P.M. then
a light breeze sprang up and we took our An-
chor and stood out to sea at 6 P.M.
Graham's Is. bore E by S. or rather S by E by E -

Thursday Strong Winds and pleasant. Chart Island a
Sept 6 Head at 10 A.M. Port of Island leaving at 10
Dis 30 m. at 2 P.M. Close into Chart Island
Hear the Capt. went on shore to get the men on
Sept then took at 7 P.M. rel. the man some
Batter. So as to do duty on shore looks and then
off shore so looks then 34 hours -

Friday Comd. With Light Breezes middle part. Saw
Sept 7 At 4 P.M. Seemingly Ship Phoenix a sailing
or rather cutting in a whale. had just come from
Chart Island off in 1 hour bearing N.E. Oct 15.
Mr. Good? Island off Weather's Island. 35 m.

Sunday Breeze Wind then 2 last days and squally
Sept 9 Comm. N. to day at 2 P.M. Squally Ship
Phoenix of N. W. Ch. Boiling. at Sea seen
Took in light sails and about 100 lbs of sails -

Sunday Strong Winds and Clear Weather running down
Sept 10 By the Island of Albatross took a steam
Round the Rock Hellands into the bay saw nothing
Worthy remark. 7 days a Cruising for S. Whales

Monday Breeze Wind then last 3 days. And pleasant
Sept 11 Cruising around and in sight of the Island
Saw land got nothing. Later a sail yesterday

Thursday Comd. With Light Breezes and pleasant. Weather fine
Sept 12 To the at line E. for Chart Island at daylight saw
at sail off the Port at 3 P.M. Spoke Ship
Phoenix again with 700 Bales. 200 or 250 Bales same

Friday Comd. With Breeze and pleasant. Steady E
Sept 21 For Chart Island. Ship Phoenix returned for store
on our course. In Sun set than looking and stood
off to the S and W. So ended this 24th

Saturday Comd. With Light Breezes fresh part standing to the
Sept 22 E. latter part shifted to S and N. Saw Chart
Island off in bay. Rather squally and rainy -

Sunday Breeze Wind then last 6 days Cruising for Spm
Sept 23 Whales had luck for have for Sun anything worth of
Remarking the Island in sight every day. On the 26th
Saw them the fore and main top gallant yards beyond
at 4 P.M. Sent them aloft again. Shortened sail at 6

Saturday Comd. With Light Breezes and pleasant. Cruising
Sept 29 as usual in ship. Spoke Sam. Porpoises. Chart
And Heard Islands in sight. Chart bearing N.E. 1/2 N.

Sunday Breeze Wind then last 3 days. Fresh part standing to
Sept 30 The S and N at 8 P.M. Squared in the yards and
Ship off for Horns Island at 11 M. Lateness of
Horns Is. and Chart off in 1 hour Dis 10 m.

October 1839

Monday Oct 1 Breeze with Light Breezes. Standing on the wind
Reported to S.E. at daylight. Spoke Spm. Whales
off the Port going under the windward - and

Tuesday Strong Breezes and Cloudy Standing to E at
Oct 2 6 A.M. Squared the yards. Comm. N. W. head
for Chart Island. At 9 Breezes around the
Island. Comm. N. at 10 P.M. a sail off
the shore. Breeze standing N. E. at 3 1/2 P.M. we
Spoke Ship Phoenix of Nantucket 10/2 m. 700
Bales. Breeze to the north. So ended this 24th
