Saturday Comd. With Light Breezes at 5 A.M. Hoisted
 Feb 23 hoisted gk. and gaskets and at 9 hoisted Anchor
 And put to sea Middle part Breeze Wind Course
 S. E. W. at Sun Set lost sight of the land (took on
 Passengers Man (English) in Santa to leave in Payton) So Eux 21st

Sunday Begins With Light Breezes and pleasant weather in
 Feb 25 Moving by the land to the S. W. later part wind
 In freshening took in top Gallies Sails and fly 1st

Tuesday Comd. With light breezy Middle part Breeze
 Feb 28 Squally Steady by the wind to the S. W. at
 Sun Set took in light Sails & S. R. top Sails -

March 1839

March 2 Light Breezes at 6 A.M. Saw Spm Whales
 Saturday at 9 A.M. the Waite Boat Landed and the
 Boat boat and Starb. G. Boat. To separate Whales they
 killed them and took them along side the Starboard G. Boat
 Got fast directly after the Waite boat but unfortunately
 got stove bad and lost the whale at Sun Set had
 got one whale cut in and began to boil So Eux -

Lat 13.49 S Long 83.30 W

Sunday Light breezy from 2 last days employed in Cutting
 March 4 And Boiling at 6 A.M. the man at the Mast head
 Perceived something a head on the water looked back
 Stood along a while and covered S. G. Boat and boat
 And it proved to be a dead V. whale. Stopped to
 Be the same one that stove the S. G. boat on 2nd
 Took it in along side and cut it in and saw on -

Friday When 4 last days been blowing Breeze. Saw no
 March 8 Spouts to day not any thing then last 4 days (but sea birds)
 Standing to sail Westward

Sunday Comd. With Breeze Winds at 9 A.M. Saw Spm Whales off
 March 10 Landed at 10 A.M. landed all 4 Boats and pulled and
 sailed till 12 Noon then came on board at 2 P.M. covered
 again Whales to land and the Starb. G. Boat got fast
 Fish and the whale took to running. fast to windward and then
 to land Presently the Waite boat got fast on whale still a
 running. and almost out sight of the ship and out of sight
 of the other Boats. at 5 all we could see was Ship's
 Top Gallies Sails on new & then. and blowing pretty fresh we
 Put from him and he him go took 2 Harpoons & 1 lance
 from waist boat whale along side
 and leave with 10 ga. above

Tuesday Light Breezes and pleasant weather first of the
 March 13 5 days in Boiling later in Breeze. Steady to Sea Boiling
 Put. Black fish and Gropers at night Shortened Sail

Wednesday When 6 last Days Light Breezes. Cruising for S.
 March 19 Whales very thick but no catch. So Sailing on in
 Steady down - Lat 13.06 S Long 84 W

Saturday Comd. to Day with light Breezes Steady by the
 March 22 Wind to the S. E. Spoke Ship Tomlin. Smith
 and from St. Peter for St. John 7.00
 300 Bells bright and Spm later part Breeze saw

Thursday When last 5 Days light Breezes employed in Boiling
 March 28 - ing 1st Sails at 6 A.M. Spoke in the gully
 and stood to the S. E. Co. 11.00. Spoke Ship
 Tomlin again yesterday - Cruising Sea nothing

27 - Spoke - Tomlin - Lat 13.24 S Long 84.20 W
 To day - " 13.54 " " 84.17 W

Sunday When 2 last days Light Breezes and pleasant saw
 March 31 Spouting of Conspicuous yesterday went down Major
 Top Sails to wear at 14 Breeze again to day at
 6 A.M. Shortened Sail. So Eux 40 -

Lat on the 30th was 13.58 S Long 82.10 W
