 Tuesday Com^d With Dr. & several buoys at day light
 Sept 24 Begun to Cut in. at 4 P.M. Tailed his Cab
 And at dusk finished hoisted topsails double
 Reef and stood to S and W. So Ends - -
 Log 88. 50 W.

Thursday Dr. & several buoys at day light
 Sept 26 In sailing at 9 P.M. Sea Spr. Tailed off
 Our Th. horn. made to toward lowered down
 2 Bouts and before we could get the lines bent
 On the whole went down when we saw them -
 Again they were to forward. boats kept on Chas
 And the Ship kept off after a long time -
 The long boat got on and the Star
 proctor darted and missed the whole so they
 came on board it being nearly dark at 8 P.M.
 Finished & Boiling steamed up 80. Making
 About 300 Tons. Fare Sat. 8. Long 88. 15 W.

Friday Strong trade employed in Steaming back from Port
 Sept 27 Steaming to Ch. & F. under double reefed topsails
 And Steaming down Co. So Ends. That 12. 20

Saturday Light Trades and pleasant weather this
 Sept. 28 day employed in Steaming down Co. in
 Top 80. 10. Steaming to S. & E. at 5 P.M.
 Finished & washed off. Chased up deck.

Sunday Standing to the S. and E. light winds at 9
 Sept. 29 A.M. Van Spr. to take off his long & beam
 We hauled aback. Dr. yd. lower lowered 3 Bouts
 And sailed to toward at 10 A.M. the S. G. boat
 Fast and the Hesperus (long) got on and they
 Barometer dashed. And missed to take got preferred
 And went quick to windward gain Chas
 Till up and came on board. Steamed by it
 And then to S. Sail saw the whole of boat
 Weathered & beam at Sun Set. Saw them a
 Breaching off Weathering Port 3/4 mile off took
 In light sails and dived up a topsails. Blacked
 Ship bound to S. and the latter part winds same -
 Sat. 8. Long 88. 15 W.

 Sept 30 Ship Standing to S. and E. under double reefed topsails at
 2 P.M. Saw Spr. Whales a making while away
 Off our weather. Saw 5 miles of it. out to sea
 And stood along his the boat then. Hear of our beam
 Saw them Spr. off. of deck it being so late and the
 Whales to windward. did not longer found that they were
 A going about S. W. & S. Stand on the 10 P.M. were Ship
 Sat. 6. 14 S. Long 89. 40 W.

Tuesday Com^d With Light Trades employed in Steaming Co. at
 Oct 1 A P.M. finished Steaming and washed off deck.
 Our set. found Dr. main sail to Eng. W. & C.
 Sat. 7. 10 S. Long 88. 15 W.

Thursday Light trades and pleasant at day light Van a
 Oct 3 Sail off our low long Steaming to S. & W. Sat
 7 1/2 P.M. The back and stood up across our 90.
 Supposed to be Rh. Prison of Sp. S. Sat. 8.
 Then to day. 6 P.M. Shortened sail. So ends
 Sat. 7. 09 S. Long 89. 30 W.

Saturday Com^d With Strong Winds and Cloudy weather
 Oct 5 At 8 P.M. Scafford in yards and stood a course
 To S. & W. & S. Saw a number of fair backed
 Sails past wind came to P.M. Shortened sail
 And brought Ship to the wind. So Ends 24. 20

Sunday
 Oct 6 Strong Breeze Steaming to S. & W. by the Wind
 Under 2 P. topsails at 8 A.M. Shook out
 Reefs and Vals. Main top & Vail at 7 A.M. we
 Squared in yards and took bound to S. & E. & S. Coast
 Middle part towards more with took in the
 Main top & Vail & Double Reef top sail. at 6 -
 Found main sail. 22. Ends - then 24. 20
 Sat 8. 04 S. Long 90. 36 W.
