July 13 11 A.M. saw 1 whale a head going quick  
to windward covered and chased the

July 18 5 1/2 saw 7 whales off W. Horn. Sail off

1 sail W. Horn. Stand 9 to 11 luffed to wind  
Oct. 6. 42. P. Long 87. 10

Monday Had strong winds. Some look date have  
been creeping. but not seen any whale  
July 27 Saw plenty ships to day spoke ship Chile  
10 and 450. Capt went on board 5. S. 87 W

Wednesday Com. with light winds and pleasant weather  
July 29 At 1 P.M. saw a sail off the long stand  
for us 3 spoke the Chile. Capt. came on  
board. kept off to N.W. better part wind same  
Crew complained of bad usage & sound -

of Chas. Island

Wednesday Light winds and squally weather rain, comm  
Aug 12 Since last date has been off the S.E. & N.W.  
To day saw a sail of the quarter running  
M. kept A.M. thought this off our lee beam  
At 9 P.M. saw his main yard whaling luff of and  
stood for here. very squally. saw another sail of  
lasted for 12. about 12. saw the first ship trace trip  
stood to the W. She had lost the run of the whale  
we stood along with square yards till 1 P.M.  
raised the whale a head. sail off. 5. saw came down  
2 P.M. both ship of us bore away. over board fast  
whale went to leeward. 2 boats kept up chase till  
5 P.M. 3 took the whale along side. 6 P.M. saw  
4 ships. At 6. took in sail. sail with heads yard  
abaft. 8 P.M. a boat from ship entered. came  
alongside. She was 12 No. 200 Bils no ship but as  
make a whale to day. (in sight)

Thursday Com. light breeze at day break Com. cutting  
Aug 13 9 A.M. made sail. stood towards the W.  
Saw a sail of D. Boat running from 11 A.M.  
spoke ship Coleconda. 8 No. 150 Bils Capt & mate  
went on board after letters. came on board and stood  
at 1 P.M. Van from whale luffed to head  
yards. main yard abaft. covered boats. all 3 boats  
got fast with the landward boats. Harpoon crew  
saw a signal for the Coleconda. She kept off. but  
did not get away. She set took 2 whales along  
side. Shortland sail. How enough in to be right  
Friday 14 finished cutting at 11 A.M. saw  
number sail. Chas Island in sight Saturday  
15 at 5 P.M. finished cutting Chas. I  
Gardner Island in sight

Sunday Foggy & Rain day light saw whale mat lost his  
Aug 16 11 A.M. came on board 8. Cleared away. saw whale to  
wind 2 sails in sight. boat followed us we  
covered again got fast but Harpoon crew  
6 P.M. came on board no whale  
17 Rainy saw 2 sails of D. boat
