Monday March 1841

Since last ^{date} we had a S.E. wind ahead
 When beating to the S. today we found our
 Selves in Lat 42.10 S. Long 81 W. at 7
 P.M. we took a fair wind fr. S. proved light
 till 4 P.M. On Tuesday morning carrying all
 Vail Studding Sails out, Wind & Sea increased
 To nearly a gale took in light Sails, main topsail
 & jib parted 12 noon closed down single reefed
 topsails. 3 P.M. wind still increasing and a
 tremendous heavy sea keeping the ship
 still on her beam before the wind. Raking her
 gunwales under, took in on deck bow & mast
 boats, stowed one in hoisting, & P.M. blowing
 a complete gale close hauled topsails furled
 Mizzen topsail, Main sail, Co. S.E. before the wind at 11 P.M.
 shipped a heavy sea carried away Star board gun
 boat, took in fore topsail & jib foresail

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Tuesday, 11th Morning a Gale at 3 A.M. found it unsafe
Mar 12 To run any longer both ⁱⁿ main topsails & fore sail & ordered
Mizen staysail mached in opportunity & Brought
The Ship to the wind 12 noon Gale same ship
making rather bad weather. Current past wind same

Wednesday Apr 11 A.M. blowing snow driving at times -
Apr. 11 3 P.M. wind up. Sak topsails close. Hoped
off before the wind. No observations - Snow & S.E.
