

Ship Marcus Capt J H Taber Bound Round Capehorn

Tuesday Oct 22^d 1844

Commenced with fresh breeze from the N E at 10 A M the pilot came on board and commenced getting under weigh took our anchor at 10 and proceeded down the bay at 12 noon halloed aboard main yard so ends

Wednesday Oct 23 1844

Commenced with fresh breeze from the N E at 12 P M the Rev Mr Roberts made it hoist and then left with the pilot and the ship at 1 P M several vessels in sight employed in stowing anchors clearing away &c at 4 P M remained 1.5 miles distance bearing S W rounded Lat 39 07 N her ship I by W furled the mainsail and No 1 gyabants at 5 P M rounded reefed the topsails and furled the fore Lat 40 20 W at 6 close hauled to middle part of cable at 8 P M the ship started to the Northward at 6 A M took the reef out the fore sail set the fore and main sail and hauled up J E by employed getting under weigh and so ends

Thursday Oct 24 1844

first part strong breeze from N E to N E by E steering S E by E employed in ships duty at 6 P M hauled reefed Lat 35 05 N Mizzen hoisted and worked the mainsail middle part hazy latter part fresh gale from the N E by E at 2 A M took reefed the topsails and took in the fore at 4 A M furled fore and mizen topsails and so ends
