

Thursday Feb 1st 1845
Began with fine breezes from the
N. by E. blowing on the wind to the Lat 38° 00'
I made the first haulings with heavy
springs from 8 to 10 fathoms and under Lat 32° 40'
Storm sails changed up at 7 P.M. set
double reef. Drifted at 9 P.M. 1/2
off my heavy gale kept her off
W. by N. took in fur and mizen
to make 2 men sick of duty and so
ends

Friday Feb 2nd 1845
Began with fresh gale from off N. by E.
steering N. by E. at 1 P.M. set the Lat 33° 00'
four and mizen to make moderate breeze
moderate breeze set all sail at 6 P.M. Lat 32° 40'
moderate breeze shifted the off 3 P.M. 1/2
W. by N. arranged to take in sail and
have her the 1/2 sail in sight. Steering
to the Westward so ends

Saturday Feb 3rd 1845
Began with fresh breeze from off N. by E.
and steering at 3 P.M. set double reef to make Lat 30° 00'
and felt moderate breeze again squared
tack in sail morning 1 P.M. Lat 27° 40' Lat 26° 00'
sailed the ship from the 1/2 P.M. 1/2
capt. Thomas joined to the 1/2 P.M. 1/2
head of the foremast and felt
even gale but at 1 P.M. men at 8 P.M.
1/2 P.M. ends

Sunday Feb 4th 1845
Began with strong breeze from off N. by E.
by 9 P.M. steering N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
gale with rain and 1/2 P.M. 1/2
to better part more moderate east
reg the 1/2 P.M. ends

Monday Feb 5th 1845
Began with fresh breeze from off N. by E.
steering N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
hark wind 1/2 P.M. 1/2 with heavy
weather heading N. by E. compass and Lat 28° 25'
so ends

Tuesday Feb 6th 1845
Began with fresh gale from the N. by E.
steering on the wind to the north at 7 P.M. Lat 27° 50'
1/2 P.M. took in the fur and mizen the courses
moderate breeze took in fur and mizen to make
better part the sun so ends

Wednesday Feb 7th 1845
Began with fresh gale from the N. by E.
steering at 1 P.M. heading up at close noon Lat 26° 00'
1/2 P.M. 1/2 and mizen heading N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
caught 2 porpoises middle and lat 26° 40' 1/2
fresh breezes so ends

Thursday Feb 8th 1845
Began with fresh breezes from off N. by E.
heading N. by E. 1 P.M. 1/2 porpoises middle and
lat 26° 40' the sun so ends

Friday Feb 9th 1845
Began with fresh breezes from off N. by E.
in sight steering to the N. by E. at 1 P.M. 1/2
ship to the N. by E. middle and lat 26° 40' 1/2
light breezes with fresh fog. Drifted
south from 8 P.M. saw fin back so ends

Saturday Feb 10th 1845
Began with light breezes from off N. by E.
foggy weather at 5 P.M. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
to the middle part the same lat 26° 40' 1/2
fine weather and light breeze from 1/2 P.M. 1/2
the mizen top gallant yards so ends

Sunday Feb 11th 1845
Began with light breeze from off N. by E.
covered four top gallant yards at the noon 1/2
on the mizen and parrelled down lat middle
and better part light breeze from 1/2 P.M. 1/2
and so ends

Monday Feb 12th 1845
Began with light breezes from off N. by E.
steering N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
part light breezes from 1/2 P.M. 1/2
duty fully 1/2 P.M. 1/2 taken with 1/2
and so ends

Tuesday Feb 13th 1845
Began with light breezes from off N. by E.
on the wind to the N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
middle part wind 1/2 P.M. 1/2 better part
the same so ends

Wednesday Feb 14th 1845
Began with fresh breezes from off N. by E.
steering on the wind to the N. by E. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
at 1 P.M. 1/2 P.M. 1/2 respect the 1/2 P.M. 1/2
at 8 P.M. took in the fur and mizen
moderate breeze with rain, wind from
the N. by E. to 9 P.M. 1/2 P.M. 1/2
at 6 P.M. saw blackfish with some
ends and so ends
