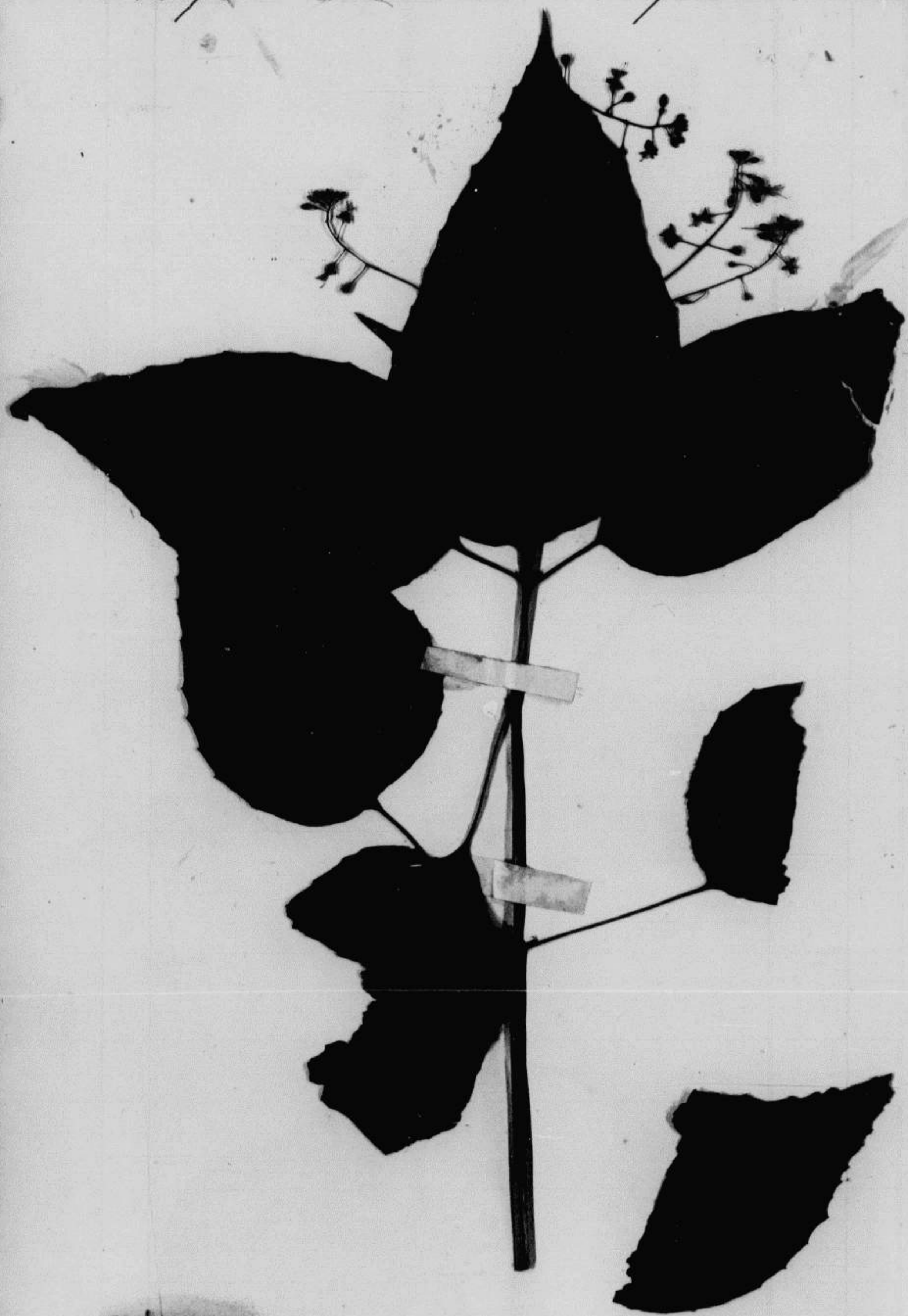


Ship Marcus Capt Taler

Syracuse

Bound to New Zealand

Mon. Sept 1st 1845
Begins with strong breezes from S.E. Lat 23 18
steering S.W. and down the coast the
gallant yard with squalls of rain Lon 165 10 W
and so ends

Tuesday Sept 2d 18 45
Begins with strong breezes from S.E.
steering S.W. with squalls of wind and
rain sent in the flying jib boom
employed in various jobs and Lon 167 10
so ends

Wednesday Sept 3d 18 45
Begins with strong breezes from the
S.E. steering S.W. for the coasts about Lat 26 32
squalls of wind and rain making
hull gasket so ends Lon 168 15

Thursday Sept 4th 18 45
Begins with strong breezes from S.E.
by E steering S.W. by S employed in sailing Lat 28 01
up the foremast masts stays the tops
employed in getting out the fore mast
hauled up so ends this day four
hours Lon 173 33

Friday Sept 5th 18 45
Begins with strong breezes from E.N.E.
steering S.W. by S employed in sailing Lat 29 11
up the main topmast back stays out
the foremast and bent one other gasket
hauled at 10 A.M. proceeded the fore mast
hook in all sail and here the ship to
stand quarter watches 5 P.M. on board
the main topmast to repair and
so ends Lon 175 00

Saturday Sept 6th 18 45
Begins with strong breezes from the
S.E. steering S.W. with some rain Lat 30 00
employed in mending the main topmast
continues with heavy showers rain
and heavy squalls of wind took
small sail day light set sail
reef foremast mizen topmast and
foremast and main sail fell un-
employed in mending the main topmast
and so ends Lon 178 40

Sunday Sept 7th 18 45
Begins with strong gales from
the S.E. steering S.W. at 1 P.M. Lat
went ship to the mainmast and took
all sail day light set the foremast
and mizen topmast sails squalls of rain
so ends Lon 180 00
