

Wednesday Feb 18th 46

Began with fine weather strong breezes from the N^W off and on at 4 boat loads off in the off being showers of rain from the night daylight collect all hands washed of decks and cut up the muzzel middle and latter parts equally one boat on shore on duty so ends

Thursday Feb 19th 46

Began with thick and squally light winds from the N^W at 10 the captain came off Lat and we left the island off that passes once more carrying all sail 10 boats left at 12 Long in the night to the E impeded in various jobs middle and latter parts the same so ends

Friday Feb 20th 46

Began with fine weather light winds from the N^W heading ESE at 1 sail on sea at 8 the boat on night worked out for water took in the main top galley each daylight washed off decks middle and latter parts the same so ends

Saturday Feb 21st 46

Began with fine weather light winds from the N^W steering on for the land the first came of the us being off and on daylight went on shore with 10 craft off each for water fresh from and took them along side so ends

Sunday Feb 22nd 46

Began with fine weather light winds and calm haul in the water got out more each sent them on shore one boat over stepped all night daylight sent 1 boat on shore to help tow off the water middle and latter parts the same so ends

Monday Feb 23rd 46

Began with fine weather light winds and baffling 1 boat on shore the 7 off the men refused duty and quit them in view they allowed to quit but 3 of them at 6 AM the rest came on duty they names Samuel Euler Lias Runkhab Aaron Brown in view meed Lovel Grys James Lawton Alexander Statham middle and latter parts the same so ends

Tuesday Feb 24th 46

Began with fine weather light winds and baffling shake the ship proper sail swell the captain on shore and one middle the middle came of at sundown daylight the other middle went on liberty middle parts fine weather latter parts strong breezes and heavy showers of rain impeded at in ship duty so ends

Wednesday Feb 25th

Began with thick and squally strong breezes from the S^W at sunset steering Lat E the captain gave the ship up to the mate to go on on a cruise on the off shore Long left the bay on shore with the captain the middle came of at sunset cap the ship off middle parts for various jobs for parts strong gale doublet masted the topsails took in the mainsail and jib and main spread so ends

Thursday Feb 26th 46

Began with strong gale from the S^W steering N^W saw the use of Sails Lat 23 47 took in the four topsails daylight set the star and main topsails muzzel and jib Long 12 52 and turned the mast out of the main top middle part thick and heavy showers of rain latter parts more moderate so ends

Friday Feb 27th 46

Began with strong breeze from the S^W steering on the wind to the N^W Lat 23 56 in the night in various jobs at 10 the came on to blow doublet masted the topsails Long 12 49 at 11 AM took in the muzzel and jib and four topsails middle parts strong gale latter parts thick and rainy took in the spanker so ends

Saturday Feb 28th 46

Began with strong gale from the N^W heading ESE with heavy showers Lat 22 38 of rain at 5 PM did not masted the main top with a heavy gale of wind at 6 took Long 12 25 in the forenoon sharp daylight set the four sail and main topsails turned the mast out of the main top middle part the fore part masted 10 men one up middle parts the same latter parts more moderate so ends
