

Sunday April 17th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E heading NE
at daylight made sail at 7 AM Lat 5 15
saw brackles on the lee bow at 8 AM
saw small sharks but could not
tell what they were at 11 AM
saw more white water off the lee
bow and off for the same NE
ends

Monday April 20th 46
Begins with fine weather light breezes
from E by S heading NE for Lat 6 20
the white water & NE started
at 5 AM the ship to the windward 122 30
and took in sail for the night
made all sail at daylight we left
the main & gallant sails sent down
the yards to fit the rigging
so ends

Tuesday April 21st 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E heading NE Lat 5 33
the gallant sail was reefed the main
the gallant sail was reefed for the night
at daylight set the main and sent
the main to the gallant sail we
piled in fitting flying jibs and
so ends

Wednesday April 22nd 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from E by S heading NE Lat 5 23
at 8 AM the light made sail
and were ship to the windward Long 122 40
we made up of new foot rope
for the four topsail yards sent
out the flying jib and so ends

Thursday April 23rd 46
Begins with fine weather light
breezes from E by S heading NE Lat 5 20
at daylight for water sent up the
main & gallant sails sent up
at 10 AM for the night at
daylight made sail on the four
topsail & we were employed in
mending & fitted the gear & sails
on the four topsail yards

Friday April 24th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E heading NE Lat 4 50
the main & gallant sails were reefed
and sent up the ship for the Long 122 00
at daylight made all sail the
water employed in making sail
and other various jobs so ends

Saturday April 25th 46
Begins with fine weather light
breezes from E by S heading NE Lat 4 33
saw porpoises employed in various
jobs at daylight made all sail Long 121 50
were ship to the S saw blackfish
goatsuckers and porpoises employed
in various jobs so ends

Sunday April 26th 46
Begins with fine weather light breezes
from the E by S heading NE Lat 5 23
out for corn and water employed
the 10 sails for the night at Long 122 60
at daylight made all sail small
and better parts for the same so ends

Monday April 27th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E by S heading NE Lat 6 33
in the night to the S by E sent
blackfish courses & boats did not Long 123 00
at daylight made all sail on
sent for the main & gallant sails
and saw brackles so ends

Tuesday April 28th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E by S heading NE
at 8 AM saw white water for the
sail and were ship to the NE
at 10 AM the light made all sail
made all sail muddled and better
parts squaredly so ends

Wednesday April 29th 46
Begins with strong breezes from
the E by S heading NE Lat 6 10
and squally weather light in
sail for the night at daylight
turned the reef out of the main
topsail & locked the main and
jib but set part to the same
so ends
