Friday May 1st 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 6 10
E & S saw nothing washed over
the main to the mast for the night Long 122 44
at daylight made sail washed
off light saw 3 large sperm
whales to points forward of the
be seen toward 3 hours but
none of them from the ship came
on board and for the ship off
at dawn nothing more seen for
specially so ends

Saturday May 2nd 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 6 08
at 2 P.M. up to the E & S
E took in sail for the night at
daylight made sail more ship to
the E & S saw nothing so ends

Sunday May 3rd 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 6 08
looked out for four hours in sail
for the night at daylight made
sail saw nothing so ends

Monday May 4th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading
E & S took in the mainsail
for the night at daylight set
mainsail broke out for water
and birds so ends

Tuesday May 5th 46
Begins with strong breezes from
the E heading E & S going back to Lat 6 35
the off at daylight and took in the
mainsail and gill at daylight Long 122 40
made sail saw the ship heading
E & S at daylight part suggest
so ends

Wednesday May 6th 46
Begins with rugged weather and
strong breezes from the E & S
heading E & S took in the mainsail
and gill at daylight set them at
gale so ends

Thursday May 7th 46
Begins with rugged weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading
in the night the off at daylight
in sail for the night at daylight
washed off sails so ends

Friday May 8th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 6 00
the wind to the E & S broke out
for the night at daylight set
mainsail in the light and mainsail
broke out to meet so ends

Saturday May 9th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 5 51
in the night to the E & S broke
ship to the E & S in the mainsail
for the night at daylight set
mainsail and gill at daylight
saw more birds so ends

Sunday May 10th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading Lat 5 15
employed in various jobs but in
sail at daylight set the mainsail Long 123 27
and gill so ends

Monday May 11th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E & S heading E & S
took in sail for the night at daylight
looked the masts out of the
ship's so ends

Tuesday May 12th 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breezes from the E heading E & S Long 124 55
set up the mainsail back stay
look in the mainsail so ends

Wednesday May 13th 46
Begins with variable weather strong
breezes from the E heading E & S Lat 5 51
employed in fitting rigging for the night at daylight
the mainsail for the night at daylight
made sail saw four birds so ends
