

Friday May 29th 46
Begins with fine weather light breeze
2 boats on shore getting off water
and so ends

Saturday May 30th 46
Begins with fine weather light
breeze and calm finished getting
off masts and lost the island off
the bar steering at 10 at daylight
employed in drying the potatoes
and steering them away so ends

Sunday May 31st 46
Begins with heavy squalls of wind Lat 21 1/2
and masts broke out for anchor
steering N.W. the wind baffling
so ends

Monday June 1st 46
Begins with strong breeze from Lat 19 5/8
the 2 steering N.W. at daylight
the masts employed in cutting with Long 130 1/2
saw blackfish so ends

Tuesday June 2nd 46
Begins with fine weather strong
breeze from the E steering N.W.
the masts called to the E to get out Long 132 20 mi
for water and did not get the
barn on so ends

Wednesday June 3rd 46
Begins with strong gale from the
steering N.W. and 2 boats employed
in mending masts. At 10 the
boats in carrying the stuff at 8
in the evening both the boats hauled back
at 11 both took in single reefed the
topsails so ends

Thursday June 4th 46
Begins with strong gale from the Lat 16 44
steering N.W. with 2 boats
weather calm many squalls of rain and Long 133 1/2
wrote down the night for fear of rain
weather so ends

Friday June 5th 46
Begins with light breeze from the Lat
N.W. heading N.E. with all sails Long
set saw porpoises latter part greatly
so ends

Saturday June 6th 46
Begins with light breeze from the Lat 15 22
steering N.W. by N. with 2
boats. The wind shifted to the N with
breeze saw seals at 5 P.M. and Long 134 3/2
wrote down the night for fear of rain
weather so ends

Sunday June 7th 46
Begins with light breeze from the Lat 14 06
the 2 steering N.W. with 2 boats
saw seals at 11 the masts called to the E Long 135 5/8
the masts and latter part the
saw so ends

Monday June 8th 46
Begins with fine weather light breeze Lat 13 10
from the E steering N.W. by N
saw nothing middle and latter parts the Long 136 5/8
saw so ends

Tuesday June 9th 46
Begins with fine weather light breeze
from E steering N.W. broke out for Lat 12 20 1/2
dried a pistol and water mules and
latter part the saw the masts from Long 138 5/8
the E set the gear against sailing
saw so ends

Wednesday June 10th 46
Begins with fine weather light breeze Lat 11 30
from the E steering N.W. by N
N.W. middle and latter parts calm Long 139 3/8
saw porpoises so ends

Thursday June 11th 46
Begins with fine weather light
breeze from the E steering N.W. Lat 10 32
N.W. saw the sailing of masts in
one off the gear 2 boats
on shore weather calm having N.W.
miles middle and latter part
the sun so ends

Friday June 12th 46
Begins with fine weather light
breeze from the E steering N.W. Lat 10 18
the island 15 miles 6 islands in
sight caught 2 porpoises saw 2 seals Long 138 5/8
one came some off saw the ship
messengers saying of and on the
sailing masts and latter part
calm so ends
