

Remarks On Board of Ship. Haringo of New

Monday October 10th 1859. Commencing with light air and squalls steering to the South and West. Middle and Latter part light baffling air with squalls of rain. Watchmen variously employed. Cooper repairing old bask. So Ends in

Tuesday Oct 11th Continues light baffling air heading to the Southward. Middle and Latter part light breezes steering to the Southward. Cooper employed as usual. Crew variously employed. Nothing in sight worthy of note. So Ends in
Lat by Obs 19. 46 N

Wednesday Oct 12th Light breezes the first part of this day heading S. S. W. Middle part light breezes. Latter part moderate breezes steering S. S. W. Saw several strange sails. So Ends in
Lat by Obs 7. 59 N. Long by Obs 22. 31 W

Thursday Oct 13th Commencing with fresh breeze from the Eastward steering S. by W. Started one bbl Beef & Pork. Middle and Latter part moderate breezes steering various course. Ends squally with showers of rain & sail in sight. No Obs

Friday Oct 14th First part moderate breezes from the Eastward steering S. S. W. Middle and Latter part light baffling air with squalls of rain. Started one bbl of Flour. 2 sails in sight. No Obs

Saturday Oct 15th Continues light baffling air and rainier weather heading to the S. W. Middle and Latter part light air and calm ambient for top of sail to repair. light showers of rain. at intervals. Watchmen employed in making Spun yarn. Malt &c
Lat by Obs 5. 15 N. Long by Obs 22. 25 W

Wild Master Outward Bound 1859

Friday October 28th 1859. Light breezes first part of this day steering South. we find the chronometer 15 miles to the Eastward. at sunset the Island bore W. N. W. Middle and Latter part light breezes steering S. S. E. Watchmen employed on the rigging & other jobs. Cooper making buckets &c. Saw nothing worthy of remark. Lat by Obs 22. 60 South

Saturday Oct 29th continues light breezes steering S. S. E. Middle part light breezes. Latter part moderate breezes steering S. S. E. by S. employed in Sunday jobs on the rigging. Nothing in sight worthy of remark. So Ends in
Lat by Obs 23. 15

Sunday Oct 30th Light breezes first part of this day steering S. S. E. started 1 bbl Beef & 1 of Pork & 1 bbl of Flour. Middle and Latter part light breezes and pleasant weather steering S. S. E. one strange sail in sight. Lat by Obs 24. 37 S. Long by Obs 26. 32 W

Monday Oct 31st First part light breezes steering S. S. E. Middle and Latter part moderate breezes steering S. S. E. at 9 AM spoke Banks Ocean River of Matanzas nothing seen leaving the Islands. Watchmen employed in weaving Malt putting them on backstays &c &c. Lat by Obs 25. 15 S. Long by Obs 25. 07 W

Tuesday November 1st 1859. Commences moderate breezes at 3 PM Exchanged signals with a small Bark steering to the Northward. Middle and Latter part fresh breezes steering S. S. E. Watchmen employed in various jobs. So Ends in

Latitude 28. 15 S
