Thursday Nov 3^d First part moderate breeze from the North Steering S. S. E. at 4 P.M. Squally with rain Single reefed top sails took in top W. sails and Steered S. E. Middle and Latter part Strong breezes Steering S. E. Employed in fitting and bending a new Main Spence's S. Ends
No Obs.

Friday Nov 4th Continues Strong breezes from the Southward Steering by the Wind to the Eastward. Middle part Moderate breezes Steering S. E. Latter part much the same Watches Employed in various jobs. Nothing in sight worthy of remark
Lat by Obs 32. 24 S. Long by Obs 17. 17 W

Saturday Nov 5th Light breezes the first part of this day from the S. W. Steering S. E. by S. Middle and Latter part much the same Steering by the wind to the S. E. by S. Employed in making boat sails
Lat by Obs 34. 07 S. Long by Obs 15. 14 W

Sunday Nov 6th Continues fresh breezes Steering S. E. by S. Middle and Latter part light Steering by the wind to the S. E. Saw 3 Finbacks
Lat by Obs 35. 14 S Long by Obs 13. 27 W

Monday Nov 7th First part light breezes Steering to the S. E. Middle and Latter part light breeze & A. to Saw Blackfish lowered the boats and chased but could not get away. Saw 1 in sight Steering S. S. E.
Lat by Obs 35. 32 S.
