

Remarks on Board of Ship Murenge of New Bedford

Monday March 19th 1860. Strong breezy the first part of the day from the N. by E. and steering to the Eastward. Saw Black fish. Middle and latter part strong breezy with some rain heading on different tack. Nothing in sight. Lat by Obs 48. 15 N

Tuesday March 20th. Continuing strong Gale and Cloudy with Showers of rain. Middle and latter part the same.

No Obs

Wednesday March 21st Strong Gale and rainey from the North to begin with. Middle part calm. Latter part light breezy from the N. E. W. Steering North. Saw a strange Sail. Watcher employed in fitting Studding Sail gear.

Lat by Obs 48. 28 N

Thursday March 22nd Continuing light breezy Steering N. at 4 P.M. spoke Bart Aquista of Sag Harbor 32 Montz but soon lost. Middle and latter part fresh breezy and Squally with Showers of rain from the N. E. W. Steering to the Northward. Saw Foreback.

Lat by Obs 39. 15 S. Long by Chs 177. 04 W

Friday March 23rd First part fresh breezy from the Westward Steering by the wind to the North. Started 1 bbl Beef and 1 bbl of Pork. Middle part Strong Gale and Squally with Thunder lightning and rain. Latter part strong breezy from the Westward Steering N. N. W. and North. So So Ends

Thursday April 5th 1860. Continuing fine gentle breeze. Steering N. W. by N. Middle and latter part light breezy. Steering N. W. E. employed in painting S. Boat and making up R. Yard.

Lat by Obs 16. 28 S

Friday April 6th. Commenced light breezy. Steering N. W. finished the Yard & Painted it. Middle part moderate breezy. Latter part light breezy. Steering N. W. by N. Saw the Navigator Islands to the Northward of us. Watcher employed.

Lat by Obs 4. 31 S. Long by Chs 173. 15 W

Saturday April 7th Continuing light breezy. Steering N. W. by N. Middle part calm. Latter part light breezy. Steering N. W. Watcher employed in making Spinnaker and other Sails.

Lat by Obs 13. 17 S

Sunday April 8th First part light breezy. Steering N. W. Middle part fresh breezy. Latter part light breezy. Steering N. W. by N. Started 1 bbl of Beef & 1 of Pork and have overboard one bbl of Beef that was completely rotten.

Lat by Obs 11. 02 S. Long by Chs 174. 52 W

Monday April 9th Continuing light breezy and Showers of rain. Steering N. W. Middle part fresh breezy. Latter part light breezy. Steering N. W. Watcher employed in painting the boat and putting on false keel on the boat. Making Spinnaker & various Sails.

Lat by Obs 9. 33 S

Tuesday April 10th Continuing the same bent. Rainy soot to the new Yard and sent it. Soft and set the Sail. Middle and latter part Moderate breezy and Squally with rain. Steering N. W. So Ends
