

Remarks on Board of Ship *Marango* of New Bedford

Friday May 5th 1860. First part moderate breezes
Steering N. N. W. Mid & Latter part light breezes
Steering N. N. W. Put out a new boat on the waist
boards & a new old one on the bow braces and
took in the old one to repair. Saw Finbacks

Saturday May 6th. Continues light breezes steering
N. N. W. Employed in fitting the boats & repairing
them. Started 1 Blk Pork Middle part light
breezes. Latter part moderate breezes steering N. N. W.

Monday May 7th Moderate breezes from S. W.
Steering N. N. W. Saw Finbacks & Porpoises.
Middle part the same Latter part light air &
rainy foggy weather So Ends

Tuesday May 8th First part Strong Gale from
N. N. E. and plenty rainier weather Steering
N. W. Mid & Latter part Strong breezes from
N. N. E. Steering N. W. So Ends

Wednesday May 9th Continues Strong
breezes heading to the N. W. Mid part calm
Latter part light breeze & a heavy swell from S. E.
Steering North. Employed in various jobs
finished repairing old boat. Saw Nothing

Latt by Obs 38.20 N. Long by Chron 143.25 E

Thursday May 10th Light breezes from S. E.
Steering N. W. Middle part the same Latter
part fresh breezes and thick rainy weather
from S. E. Steering N. W. Ends rainy

J. A. Wild Thrua Toward Japan Sea

Friday May 11th 1860. First part thick rainy weat-
-ter from S. E. Steering N. W. & felt double reefed
the topsails and luffed by the wind to S. E.

Middle part Strong breezes & rainy thick weather
Latter part more moderate wind from the West
Steering by the wind on different tracks

Latt by Obs 41.30 N. Long by Chron 142.20 E

Saturday May 12th Strong breezes from the
Westward Steering by the wind Middle part
Moderate breezes. Latter part light air heading
to the W. S. W. Saw the Land some part of Japan

Latt by Obs 41.10 N. Long by Chron 142.18 E

Sunday May 13th Commence light breezes from
the S. E. heading N. W. Middle and Latter parts
Light breezes & calm heading for the Land

Latt by Obs 41.12 N. Long by Chron 141.45 E

Monday May 14th Light breezes steering N.
Saw Killers lowered 2 Boats, no luck, at 7 P. M.
Entering the Straits of Matsmai, Steering
N. N. W. by the wind. Middle part light breezes
& calm. Latter part a fine breeze from N. E.
Steering to the Westward through the Straits
Saw Several Japanese Junk &c 1 Blk Pork

Tuesday May 15th A fine breeze from N. E.
Steering to the Westward Saw Several Junk,
a Ship a Bark & a Schooner. Middle part light
breezes steering S. W. Latter part light breezes and
thick rainy weather steering to the S. W. Saw
Killers & 3 or 4 Junk. So Ends
