

Remarks on Board Ship Mearns of New Bedford

Monday June 4th 1860. First part fresh breeze steering to the Eastward. Several ships in sight.

Middle part light breeze. Latter part the same at 7 Am saw R. Whaley & lowered for them chased until 11 A.M. and took up the boat could not get up to them 3 or 4 ships in sight that day so ends.

Sat by Obs 42. 15 N

Tuesday June 5th Continuing about the same. Cap. McQuinn's storen boat. Third part calm. Latter part light breeze. Saw the proper looking. Saw Humpbacks and a few ships finished storen boat. Nothing more of note.

Sat by Obs 42. 14 N. Long 133. 21 E

Wednesday June 6th First part moderate breeze from the Southward steering by the wind on different tacks. Saw a Whale going to windward fast lowered for him but could not catch him took up the boat. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze steering to the Eastward. Saw nothing.

Sat by Obs 42. 14 N. Long 133. 01 E

Thursday June 7th Continuing fine breeze steering to the Eastward. Striped 1 Blk Bull 1 of Pork. Mid part calm. Latter part light breeze saw a R. Whale going eye out to windward lowered the boat & chased, no luck.

Sat by Obs 42. 23 N.

Friday June 8th Continuing light air the land in sight all along shore. Chast of Tarkenton & Humpbacks. Middle and Latter part light air nothing in sight but the Land and one ship. Early light breeze & thick hazy weather.

Saturday June 23rd 1860. Commenced light breeze and fine weather heading to the S.W. Middle and Latter part light breeze & thick hazy weather trying to get to the Southward. Nothing in sight worthy of remark.

Sat by Obs 46. 14 N. Long 133. 15 E

Sunday June 24th Continuing light breeze. Opened a fog off Boston. Middle & Latter part light breeze & cloudy with showers of rain. Nothing in sight.

Monday June 25th Same old story light breeze & showers. Middle and Latter part the same. Nothing in sight.

Tuesday June 26th First part light breeze & hazy weather steering to the S.W. Saw Finbacks. Throughout the rest of this day the same old story foggy.

Wednesday June 27th Continuing foggy. Middle part clear weather. Latter part fine weather steering to the N.W. Saw a Steamer & the Land.

Sat by Obs 45. 57 N. Long by Obs 133. 27 E

Thursday June 28th Continuing fine weather and gentle breeze from S.W. steering East. Middle part light breeze. Latter part fresh breeze. Saw a Ship and the Island of. at Monahan's Hook her the Omega of Fairhaven. Healed 1200 lbs.

Friday June 29th First part fresh breeze beating to windward in company with the Omega. 2 PM landed with the Omega's boat to get Eggs. 6 PM returned with nothing. Middle part going a back. Latter part steering to the N.E. Saw the Land & a Humpback.
