

Remarks On Board of Ship *Marion* of New Bedford

Saturday June 30th 1850. Commenced fresh breeze from N.E. steering by the wind to the N.N.W. Middle part strong breeze. Latter part strong Gale & Rainy heading to the E.S.E. Under Storm Sails. Saw a Schooner.

Wanted 1 bbl Beef & 1 of Pork. So Ends

Sunday July 1st Continues strong Gale and rain. Middle part the same. Latter part strong Gale and no rain heading to the Westward.

Monday July 2nd First part a little more moderate. Middle and Latter part fresh breeze & hazy weather heading on different tack. Saw a Ship steering to the S.E. and the Land & Humphbacks & Finbacks.

Latt by Obs 47° 22' N. Long 140° 59' E

Tuesday July 3rd Continues moderate breeze from the Northward heading to the Westward. Middle and Latter part light air & calm & foggy. Saw nothing.

No Obs

Wednesday the Glorious 4th of July. Begins with light air & foggy. Middle part the same.

Latter part light breeze & hazy. Saw Humphbacks.

Latt by Obs 47° 15' N. Long 141° 19' E

Thursday July 5th Continues light breeze and pleasant weather. Saw the Land. Middle part lying aback. Latter part fine weather. Saw the Land & Humphbacks. Started 1 cask of Bread and 1 cask of Flour 4½ bbls. So Ends.

Friday July 6th Continues fine weather. Middle and Latter moderate breeze from the South heading to Windward. Saw Finbacks & the Land. So Ends.

Friday July 20th 1850. Commences moderate breeze & thick weather heading to the Westward. Middle and Latter part strong breeze & rugged heading to the S.W.

Latt by Obs 52° 54' N. Long by Chro 151° 20' E

Saturday July 21st Strong breeze the first part of this day from S.E. heading to the S.W. Saw a finback. Middle and Latter part moderate breeze from the Eastward and thick hazy foggy weather. Steering S. by E. Saw Nothing.

Sunday July 22nd Continues moderate breeze and thick weather. Steering S. by E. Middle and Latter part light breeze from the North and thick weather with showers of rain. Steering S. by E.

Monday July 23rd Continues light breeze and thick hazy weather. Steering S. by E. Middle and Latter part much the same. Steering various courses. Saw nothing and don't expect too. Ends thick weather.

Tuesday July 24th Hazy weather and a fresh breeze from N.W. Steering S.W. by W. Middle and Latter part light breeze inclining to a calm. Nothing in sight as usual.

Latt by Obs 48° 30' N. Long 147° 30' E

Wednesday July 25th Light breeze and calm heading to the S.W. Middle and Latter part light breeze & clear weather heading to the S.W.

Latt by Obs 48° 58' N. Long 146° 52' E

Thursday July 26th Continues light breeze. lowered the Boat for a Sufferbottom. did not get him. Middle lay aback. Latter part saw a Right Whale lowered and L.B. picked him and off he went. lowered again for a Humphback. no go. Saw any quantity of finbacks and the Land.

Latt 48° 30' N. Long 146° 28' E
