

Remains On Board of Ship Marango of New Bedford

Thursday August 16th 1860.

First part of this day light breezy & foggy. Finished stowing down oil. Middle part lay aback. Latter part thunder lightning & rain. Saw a R. W. lowered 3 boats but he was going too fast to catch him. Saw Humphreys & Finback. Ends cloudy.

Lat Obs

Friday August 17th. Light breezy and foggy saw Finback & started 1 bbl Beef & 1 of Pork. Middle part the same. Latter part light breezy & employed in scraping bone saw R. W. lowered 3 boats. Harbor Boat got to him started but did not fasten. Came on board. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 47. 42 N.

Saturday August 18th. Continues light breezy and cloudy saw R. W. lowered 3 boats but could not get near enough to fasten. Middle part lying aback. Latter part moderate breezy. Employed in cleaning bone. Lowered for a R. W. did not catch him. So Ends this day.

Lat by Obs 47. 52 N.

Sunday August 19th. First part fresh breezy. Saw a R. Whale lowered & chased into go. Saw Suberbottom &c. Middle and Latter parts fresh breezy & cloudy smoky weather. Saw Finback.

Lat 47. 40 N. Long 143. 45 E

Monday August 20th. Continues fresh breezy & cloudy smoky weather. Middle & Latter part fresh breezy with some rain and cloudy smoky weather. Saw Finback.

Saturday September 22nd 1860. Continues moderate breezy steering by the wind to the South 3 P. L. tacked to the Westward. Sent down cutting falls & blocks. took in staysail to repair. Middle part moderate steering W. S. W. Latter part fine breezy steering W. S. W. repaired stay sail and bent it. Ends cloudy with a boney breeze.

Lat Obs 43. 18 N. Long by Obs 147. 14 E

Sunday Sept. 23rd. Commences fresh breezy from S. E. and cloudy steering W. S. W. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezy from the Eastward and sailing steering S. W. Spilt mizen topsail &c.

Lat Obs 42. 00 N. Long by Obs 145. 01 E

Monday Sept. 24th. fresh breezy and an ugly sea the first part of this day from N. W. steering by the wind to the S. W. Middle part the same. Latter part light breezy heading to the S. W. bent a new mizen topsail. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 40. 19 N. Long by Obs 143. 58 E

Tuesday Sept. 25th. First part light air inclining to a calm. heading to the S. W. started 1 bbl Beef & 1 of Pork. Middle part heading to the N. W. Latter part fresh breezy from the Westward heading to the Northward. Unbent main sail to repair. So Ends this day.

Lat by Obs 41. 23 N. Long 144. 00 E

Wednesday Sept. 26th. Continues moderate breezy 2 P. L. tacked ship to the S. W. took filled 1 bbl Muck. Middle part moderate. Latter part fresh breezy from the Westward beating to windward. Employed in drying bone &c.

Lat Obs 41. 31 N. Long by Obs 143. 33 E

Thursday Sept. 27th. First part strong breezy heading to the N. W. by N. the Land in sight to the Westward of us. 6 P. L. tacked to the South. Middle part tacked to N. W. Land in sight. Latter part fresh breezy heading to the S. E.
