Tuesday March 19th 1861: Continues strong breeze Middle and Latter part much the same with some rain heading to the N. N. W.

Wednesday March 20th Continues strong breeze & Rainy dirty weather Steering N. N. W. Middle part lying under short sail. Latter part fresh breezes from S. E. Steering N. N. W. Watch employed in cleaning up old muskets

Thursday March 21st First part fresh breezes from S. E. Steering N. N. W. 4 P.M. Steered North Started 2 bbls Pork & 1 bbl Beef Middle part the same. Latter part Moderate breeze Steering N. N. W. Watch variously employed

Latt Obs 28° 53' S. Long by Chron 179° 30' E

Friday March 22nd Continues Moderate breeze Steering N. N. W. Middle and Latter part lying under short sail. Steering N. by W. & W. Employed in various jobs Nothing in sight worthy of remark.

Saturday March 23rd Light breeze the first part of these 24 hours Steering N. N. W. Middle and Latter part Moderate breeze from S. E. Steering N. N. W. Employed in various duties

Sunday March 24th Continues Moderate breezes Steering N. W. by N. Middle and Latter parts Light baffling winds and Clouds with Showers of rain Steering N. N. W. and N. W. by N. Ends Rainy

Monday March 25th 1861: Continues Light breeze Steering N. W. by N. 1 P.M. Saw a School of Spum Whales close to the Ship going quick to the Windward Lowered the Boats & Chased but could not come up with them 4.30 took up the Boats. Middle part Moderate. Latter part Strong breezes from N. N. E. and Rainy heading to the N. W.

Latt 20° 30' S. Long 177° 20' E

Tuesday March 26th Strong breeze & Rainy the first part of these 24 hours heading to the N. W. Middle part much the same. Latter part Strong breezes & raged with Showers of rain from the Westward Steering North. Employed variously

Latt Obs 20° 20' S. Long by Chron 177° 00' E

Wednesday March 27th First part fresh breezes Steering by the Wind to N. by E. Middle and Latter part fresh breezes Steering North & N. by W. daylight saw the Land out of the Feige Islands to the Eastward of us. Latter part saw more of the Islands. Watch employed in making Spum yarn & Sennett. Blacksmith at work at his forge making & repairing

Latt Obs 18° 57' S

Thursday March 28th Continues fresh breezes heading N. N. W. one of the Islands ahead at 4.30 Tacked Ship. to the South. Middle part fresh breeze & Squally with Showers of Rain. Latter part the same. One Island in sight. Ends Cloudy

Friday March 29th Continues fresh breeze and Squally with Showers of rain heading N. W. and W. N. W. Started 1 bbl of Beef. Middle and Latter part Moderate breeze. Steering by the Wind on different tacks. Latter part saw the Land Watch employed in Sunday jobs
