Friday June 14th 1861. Continuing light air & calm. Saw a large R.W. Lowered the boat for him but could not catch him. Employed in boiling & mending. Stove boat. Middle part calm. Latter part light air & foggy, for the most part of the time saw the Harrison & Finbacky. finished Stove boat &c.

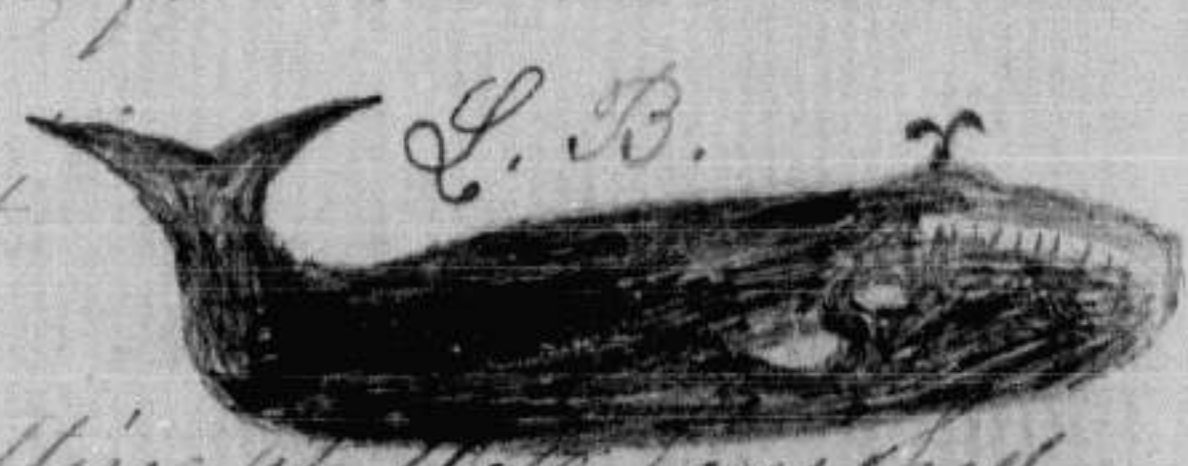
Saturday June 15th. First part light breezy saw R. Whales going E by out did not follow. 3 Bell Capt. Wood came on board the have taken 3 Whales since we saw them last. Employed in boiling. Middle and latter part light air & foggy, Employed in boiling.

Sunday June 16th. Continuing light air & foggy. 6 Bell finished boiling. Middle and latter part much the same. at Meridian lit up a little.

Monday June 17th. First part clear weather and light breezy saw R. Whales. Covered 3. Boat. Carbond boat struck 3.30 Bell took to the ship & commenced cutting. 5.30 finished. & cleared away the head. Harrison & the Land in sight. Middle part light breezy. Latter part the same saw R. Whales lowered 3 boats & chased but could not get fast. Harrison & the Land in sight.



Tuesday June 18th. Continuing fine weather & gentle breezy. 1 P.M. saw Whales and lowered the boat. Carbond boat struck 4.30. took her to the ship & commenced cutting at 11.00. finished. Latter part cleared away the head & commenced boiling. Saw a R. Whale lowered & chased but could not catch him. So Ends.



Henry Eldredge Master. Cruising in Japan Sea.

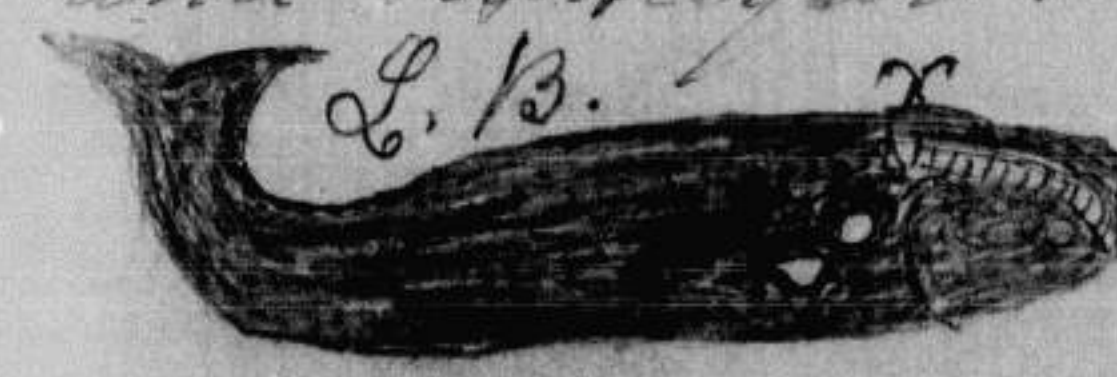
Wednesday June 19th 1861. Continuing light breezy and smoky weather. Harrison & the Land in sight and Finbacky. Employed in boiling. Middle part the same. Latter part Rainy dirty weather. Worked down the works.

Thursday June 20th. Continuing Rainy weather. Gaming with the Harrison. Middle part the same. 3 AM Started the fires again. Latter part light breezy & cloudy. Employed in boiling & stowing down.

Friday June 21th. Light breezy & cloudy the first part of this day. Boiling & stowing down. Middle part the same. Latter part light air saw R. Whales and lowered 3 boats. Carbond Boat got to a whale and darted but did not cut fast. but his friends up but the did not go in. Employed in boiling.

Saturday June 22th. Continuing light breezy saw R. W. lowered 3 boats & chased but could not cut fast. Middle part calm. Latter part light breezy & cloudy saw R. W. and lowered 3 boats & chased could not get on. took up boat 11.30 lowered again.

Sunday June 23th. Continuing light breezy and Rainy at 1 PM. Carbond Boat struck & killed 3.30 took to the ship & commenced cutting. 7.20 finished & took in salt for the night heading off shore. L.B. missed one good chance. Moderate through the night. Latter part fresh breezy. Steaming along the land. Saw R. W. and lowered 3 boats and chased the rest of this day.
