

Remarks on Board of Ship *Maunabo* of New Bedford

Sunday August 25th 1861. Thick Fog as Usual
Steering N.E. by E. Middle & Latter part clear local
and light breezy saw Finbacks steering E. N. E.

Latt by Obs 53.20 N. Long by Obs 154.50 E
Monday Aug 26th Light breezy & fine weather
the first part of this lying aback fishing for
codfish. Caught a fine St. Middle part thick fog
Latter part strong breezy from S. E. & thick Rainy
weather lying aback fishing. Ends Rainy

Tuesday Aug 27th Strong breezy & Rainy lying
aback fishing. Middle part the same. Latter part
strong breezy & thick Rainy weather steering S. by E.

Wednesday Aug 28th Continues strong breezy
and rugged dirty weather heading to the
Westward Under close reefed M. P. Sail & c.
Middle part steering South. Latter part moderate
breezy steering to the Eastward saw Finbacks
Employed in breaking but Flour & Cakes & c.

Latt Obs 52.18 N. Long by Obs 154.15 E
Thursday Aug 29th First part light breezy
and cloudy. Saw Humphbacks & Finbacks
Employed in catching Codfish. Middle
part clear. Latter part foggy fishing

Friday Aug 30th Cloudy hazy weather
12.30. Saw a R. W. going to Westward. Eyes
out. Started 2 bbls Pork. Middle and Latter
part Thick & Rainy steering various ways
Saw Finbacks & Porpoises

I don't think we have had put it all
together a good whaling day this month
if this is not still true, I don't know.

Henry Eldredge Master Cruising in *Ochotsk Sea*

Saturday Aug 31st 1861. Same old story strong
breezy & thick dirty Rainy weather. Middle part
the same. Latter part moderate & cloudy with some
Rain & light fog squally 11.30. AM Spoke Ship *Harrison*
Nothing since we saw her last. No Ends

Latt Obs 52.25 N.
Sunday September 1st Fresh breezy the first part
of this day heading to the North in company with
the *Harrison*. Middle & Latter part fresh breezy and
cloudy *Harrison* in sight & Finbacks

Latt Obs 52.15 N. Long by Obs 153.45 E
Monday Sep 2^d Moderate breezy & cloudy steering
to the Southward saw a Whaler Sail 11.2 P.M.
near night. Middle part foggy. Latter part fresh
breezy steering various ways saw a R. W. going to the
windward quick. Employed in tinning ship

Latt Obs 52.10 N. Long by Obs 153.40 E
Tuesday Sep 3^d Continues fresh breezy & vessels
in sight a R. W. came near the ship as we were
shortening sail for the night. Middle & Latter part
fresh breezy saw 4 vessels and two Whales. No Ends

Wednesday Sep 4th First part fresh breezy
Unbent Main Sail & bent the old Fore sail in its
place. Started 1 bbl of Beef. Middle & Latter part fresh
breezy steering by the wind to the South & West.

Latt Obs 50.55 N. Long by Obs 151.50 E
Thursday Sep 5th Commenced moderate breezy
from the Westward steering by the wind to the South
bottle filled 1 bbl of Whisk. Middle & Latter part light
breezy heading to the N.W. cloudy hazy weather
Employed in making a new main Hoist.

Latt Obs 50.10 N. Long by Obs 151.05 E
No light for Whales this season.

1 bbl of Beef

2 bbls Pork
